#### **ARCHIVAL RE-HOUSING OF PERISHABLE ARTIFACTS FROM NAVAJO NATIONAL MONUMENT HOUSED AT THE MUSEUM OF NORTHERN ARIZONA**

The Museum of Northern Arizona (MNA) will re-house approximately 270 perishable organic artifacts from Navajo National Monument (NAVA) into archival quality storage materials in order to properly preserve these objects. The goal of this project will be to bring these collections up to the federal standards outlined in 36 CFR Part 79, "Curation of Federally-Owned and Administered Archeological Collections" for long-term storage and improved access for scholarly research and public education.
