☐ [AGEC](#) Requirements: The Arizona General Education Curriculum (AGEC) is the foundation of a community college education in Arizona. Successfully completing the AGEC means all AGEC courses will transfer as a block to NAU. An AGEC is incorporated into some Associate degrees, and some degree requirements will also meet AGEC requirements.

☐ Emphasis Requirement: 51 units of coursework in *one* of the following approved career and technical occupation areas:

Business and Marketing
Education and Training
Family and Consumer Science
Health Careers
Industrial and Emerging Technologies
Occupational

The emphasis requirement can be met by a combination of approved transfer coursework, certificate(s) awarded by accredited institutions from related fields, National Occupational Competency Testing Institute (NOCTI) Job Ready test credit, exam-based industry certification, and/or occupational experience credit. Additional Considerations:

- An associate degree is encouraged but not required. Completion of the Emphasis requirements is not required prior to admission at NAU, but must be completed before awarding of a Bachelor's degree. Work with your community college advisor and [NAU transfer representative](#) to determine your optimal transfer timeline.
- This program is available Online.
- An [Accelerated Master's Program](#) degree option is available for eligible students. This allows students to begin their master's coursework while completing their bachelor's degree.
- You may become career and technical education certified in Arizona by providing documentation of previous occupational experience to the teacher-certification unit at the Arizona Department of Education. See your advisor for more information.
