# Amplifying Student Voice, Choice & Cultural Identity through Technology

#### Description

Discover how digital tools can support and honor Indigenous students' voice, cultural knowledge, and ways of knowing. This seminar will explore practical strategies for using technology to create learning experiences where students can share their stories, connect their cultural identities to academic content, and experience agency in learning. Participants will examine digital platforms and multimedia tools that enable students to express their learning in a variety of ways, from digital storytelling that incorporates tradition and self-expression to collaborative spaces that center Indigenous perspectives.

Ashley Esparza is a Lecturer at Northern Arizona University's College of Education where she teaches courses about Educational Technology. Previously, she worked as the Technology & Innovation Specialist in Flagstaff Unified School District where she supported teachers and staff with technology integration in K-12 classrooms. Incentives	1) Certificate of Completion (58.5 calculated hours of PD) 2) Published Curriculum Unit 3) Accepted Teachers will receive a program scholarship covering most participation costs such as some travel, meals, etc. 4) \$1,500 Stipend paid to educator at the end of the seminar. The stipend is to help offset any remaining expenses not covered by the INE (such as some travel costs).
