




STRATEGIES FOR PROVIDING EFFECTIVE FEEDBACK


Frequent formative feedback

- Use feedback to shape coursework.
- Use whole class feedback.
- Scaffold the feedback on smaller assignments to contribute to a larger project.
- Use the NAU F2S tool for positive and constructive feedback.
- Use the autofeedback tool in Bb learn.

AUTO FEEDBACK: GO TO EDIT QUESTION ONCE THE TEST IS CREATED



PROVIDE IMMEDIATE FEEDBACK THROUGH ONLINE TESTS/QUIZZES



PEER REVIEW

- Self and peer grading can help you decrease your workload.
- Assessing a peer helps them benchmark their work against the class.
 - Clear positive guidelines:
 - Additive feedback- make suggestions only about what the writer might add to or develop
 - Summary of main points and evidence
 - Provide a form for students to use to guide their comments
 - Offer grading criteria for peer reviews



- A presentation
- A poster/concept map/diagram
- A research bibliography
- Student proposed project
- Collaborative quizzes- ungraded?
- Open notes quiz (to encourage note taking skills)
- Muddiest point after class


Bloom's Taxonomy









2. How are students assigned?











- SafeAssign compares submitted assignments against a set of academic papers and Internet sources to identify areas of overlap between the submitted assignment and existing works.
- Originality reports provide detailed information about the matches found between a student's submitted paper and existing sources.
- Both instructors and students can use the report to review assignment submissions for originality and create opportunities to identify how to properly attribute sources.*




To enable SafeAssign, open **Submission Details** on the Assignment, and select **Check submissions for plagiarism using SafeAssign**






- Students must agree to have their work submitted to the Global Reference Database
- If selected by the instructor during Assignment setup, students may view their own SafeAssign Originality Report by reviewing their assignment submission







The **Originality Report** highlights phrases that have been found elsewhere electronic journals, web pages, and other student papers from NAU (Institution Database) and other schools (Global Database)




Click Open matching source in the Originality Report to see the text in its original context





Click **Dismiss match** if the match is incidental and not an academic integrity concern



- Access the SafeAssign tool from Course Tools; view all SafeAssign submissions and access originality reports in one place
- Use DirectSubmit to upload papers or text directly (e.g., if the student emails their paper, or to check discussion post text)







Tips

- Set up an ungraded Draft Assignment (select: Exclude submissions from the Institutional and Global References Databases) to allow students to check and correct their own work before submitting for a grade
- Use SafeAssign as an educational tool, not a punitive one (especially for lower-division students)
- Don't worry too much about the % overall match numbers SafeAssign can't really tell when something is cited correctly
