Curriculum to review	<p>N. Morrow explained the curriculum review forms and reminded the committee that it reviews curriculum for the Provost's Office and the programs that do not have a college curriculum committee to do the review.</p> <p>The committee had one course to review and after considerable discussion passed the following motion:</p> <p>M. Settle moved, L. Acosta seconded to approve the reactivation of MS 170 with an update/revision to the course purpose statement.
