SUMMARY

The Office of Planning and Institutional Research has conducted the Sophomore Survey since 2002. Beginning with the 2004 survey administration, students have been asked, *“If any member of the NAU faculty or staff has positively influenced your experiences at NAU, please complete the following information.”* Students are then asked to provide a name, department, and comment.

Out of the 495 students that participated in the 2016 Sophomore Survey, 277 students (56%) acknowledged one or more faculty or staff members who have positively influenced their experience at NAU. The table below summarizes the names and departments of the top faculty/staff members who were acknowledged four or more times.

Andrew Lebovitz wants his students to succeed and is extremely approachable if you are struggling. Beyond this, however, him along with a few other teachers were extremely helpful when I was in a time of need last semester, and had it not been for the help of him and a few other teachers, I would have had to go home take some time off. However, Andrew is not only willing to help you succeed academically but is willing to take the time out of his day to ensure that you succeed inside and outside of the classroom. Along with this, his approach to homework—a necessary part of mastering mathematics—was the best I have encountered thus far at this school. I was bummed to hear that he was forced to integrate WebWork into his classes this semester. In addition to Andrew, the professors who helped me immensely in a time of personal need and did not just make me feel like another student on their roster was Randy Dillingham, Kathy Eastwood, and **Andreas Sommer**. I would like to particularly note **Andreas Sommer** because he has the sincerest and kindest character I have encountered in many, many years and he went above and beyond to help me at a time that I was struggling. Both of my lab professors, Lucas Klein and John Kistler, have both been very great in their own ways. John Kistler was very helpful in bridging the gap between the physics curriculum and career opportunities outside of the classroom when he helped me get a job at Lowell Observatory. I appreciate Lucas Klein for always being approachable in lab in helping us understand physics—which should be the ultimate goal—while still keeping the professional line between helping us understand the nature of our majors and not providing us with answers. I really appreciate his approach to teaching lab in this manner because he has been really helpful in expanding my knowledge of physics beyond anything that the textbook could provide.
