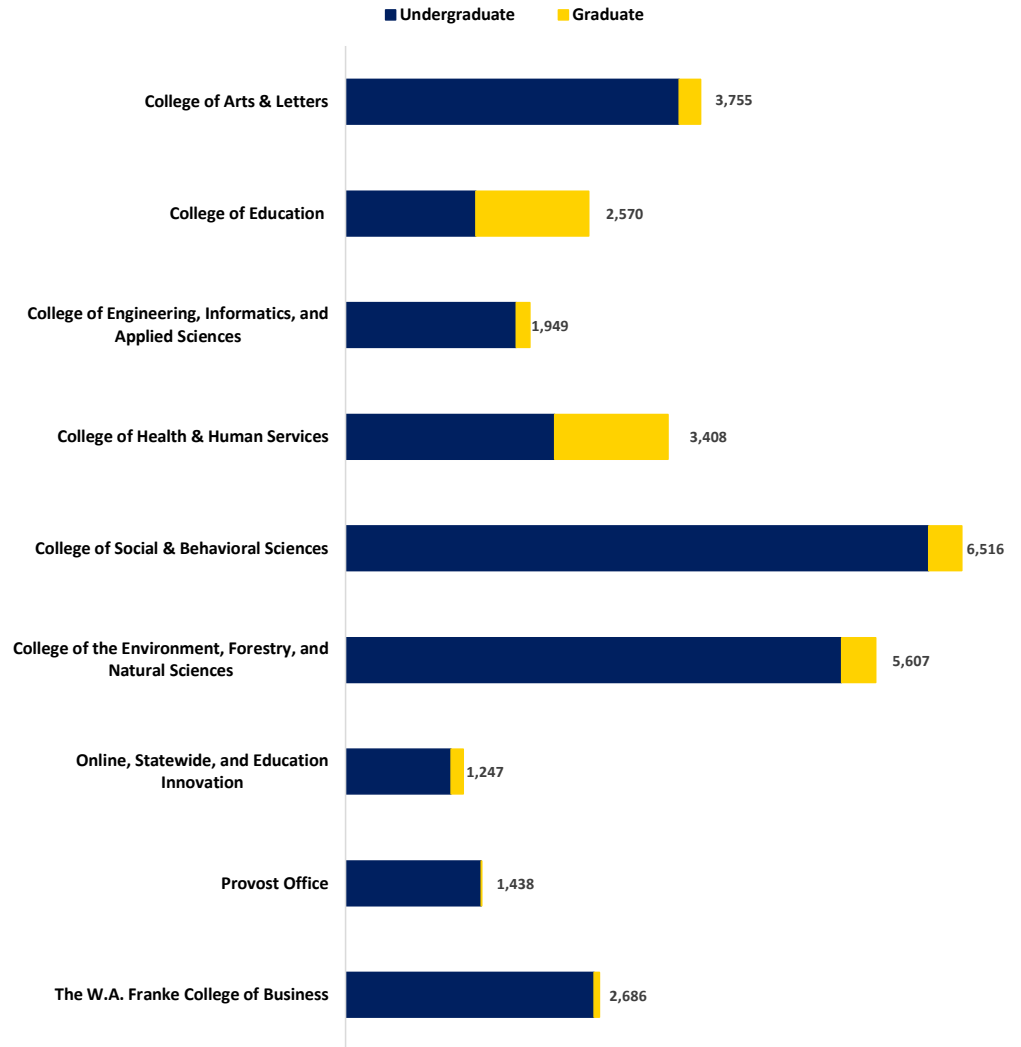

Fall 2019

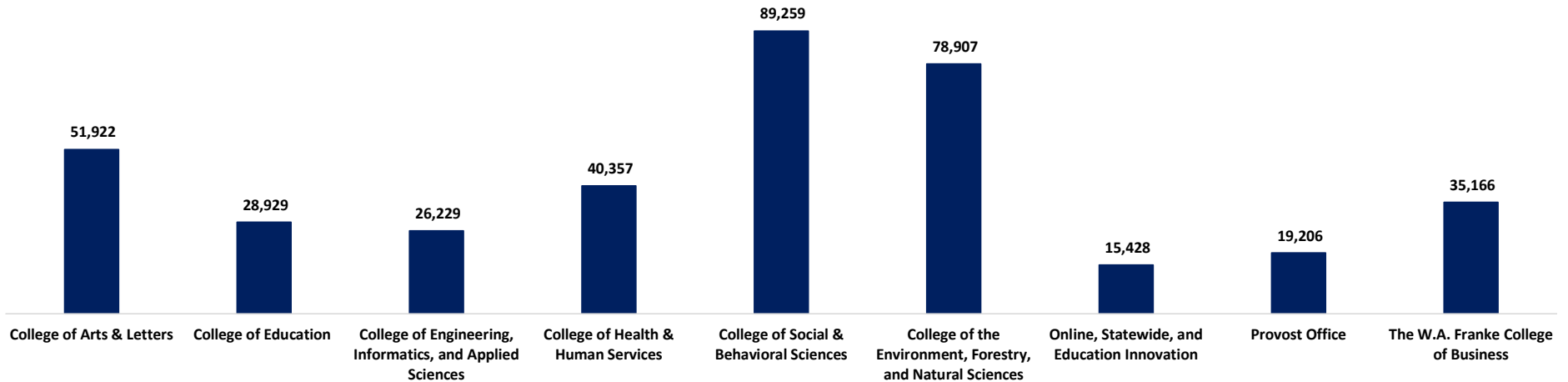

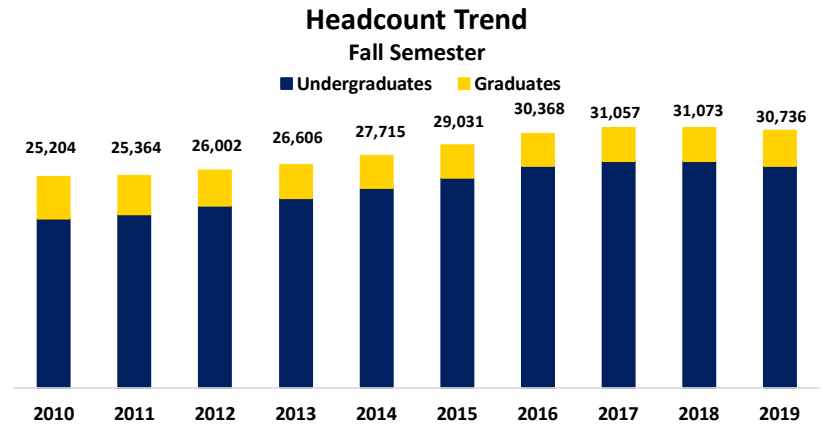
Student Credit Hours (SCH) by College
Fall 2019



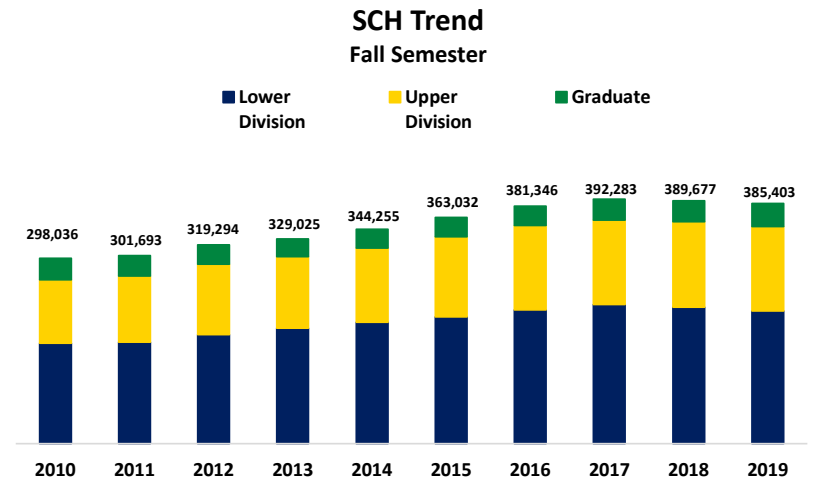

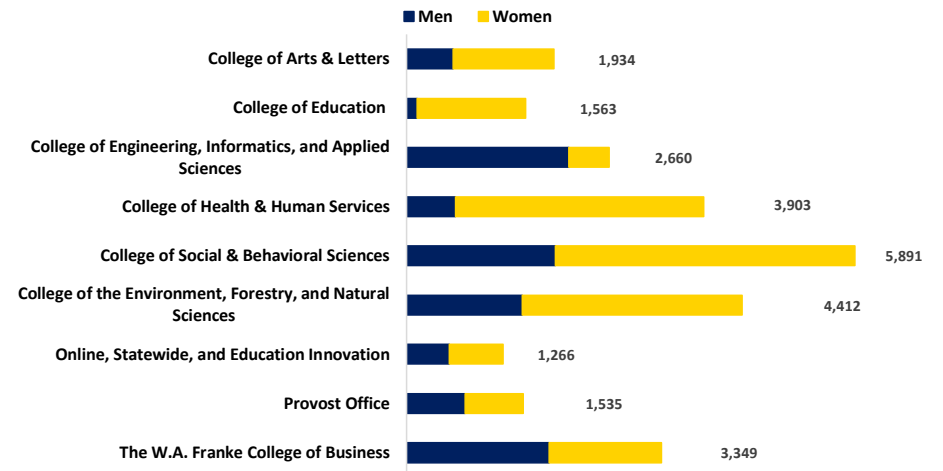

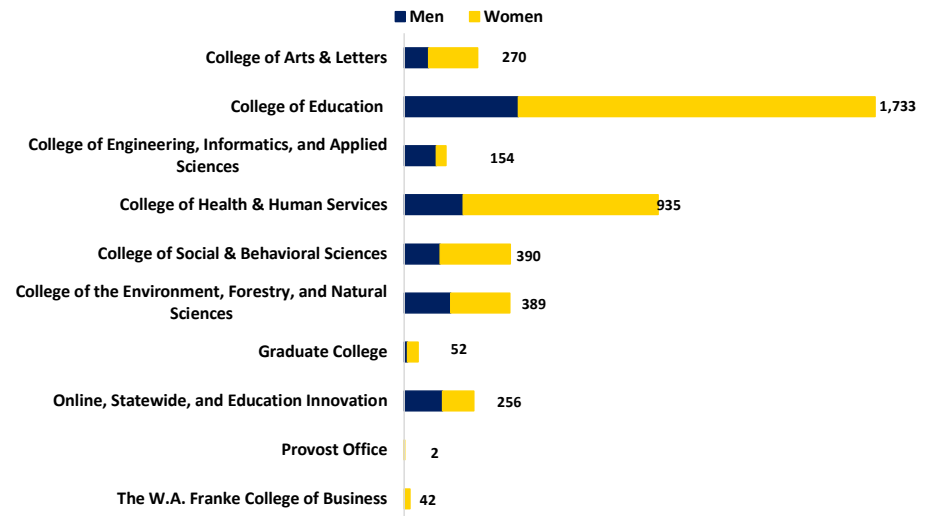

Graduate Headcount Fall 2019



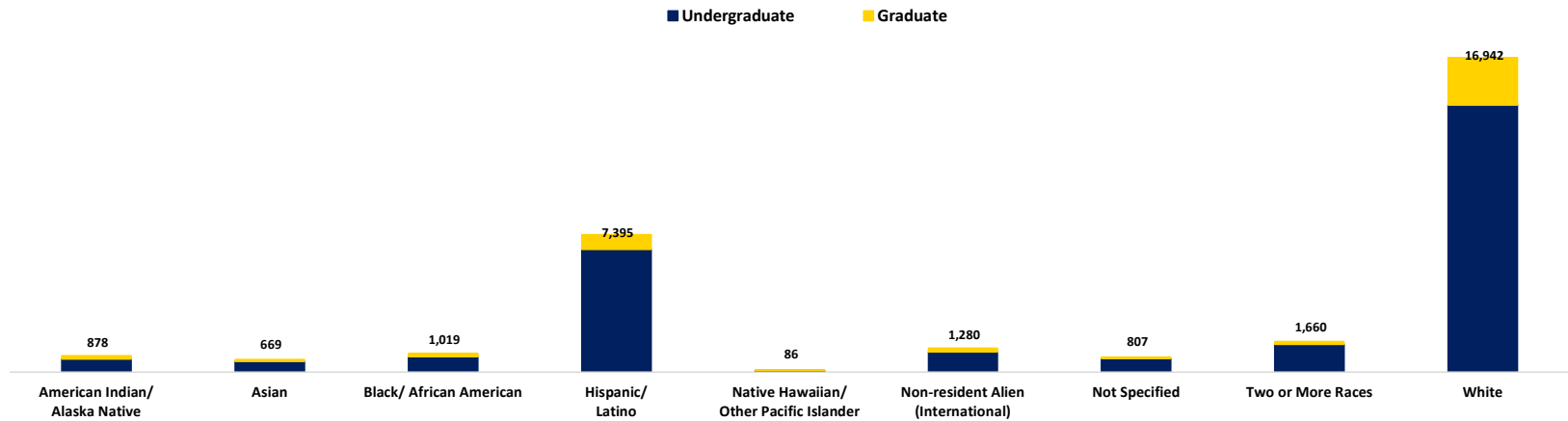

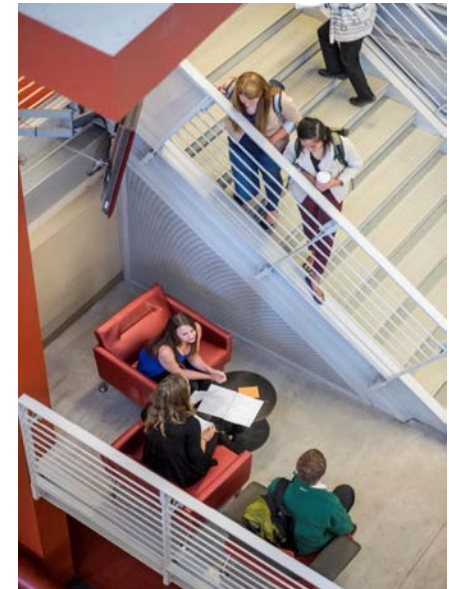

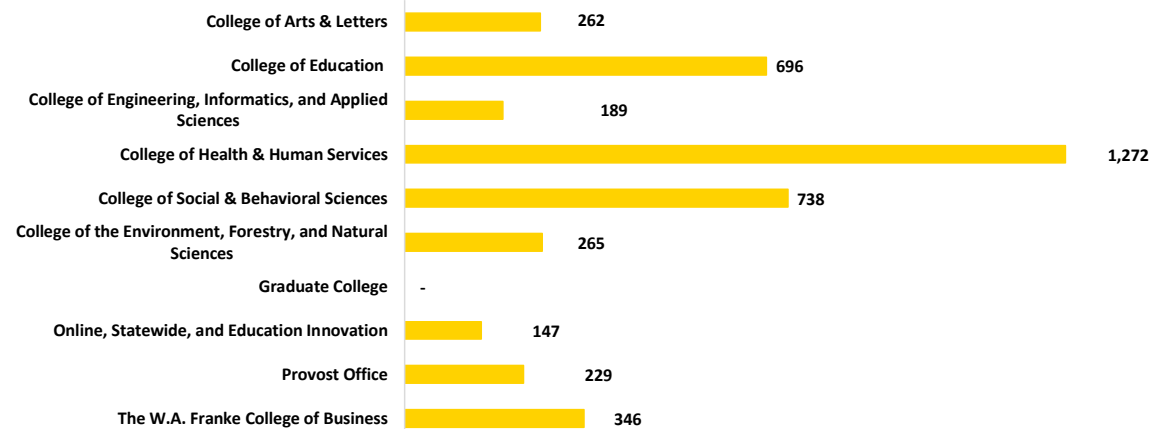

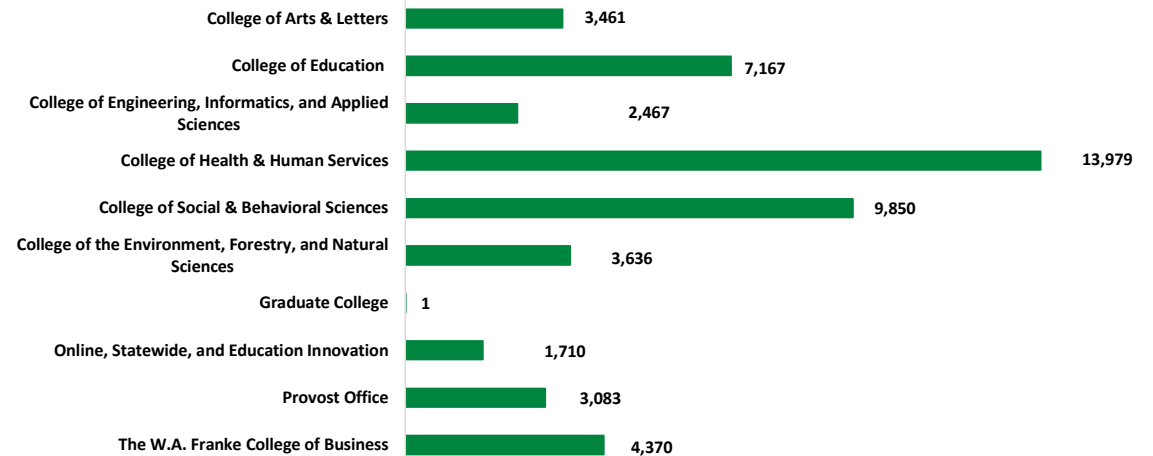

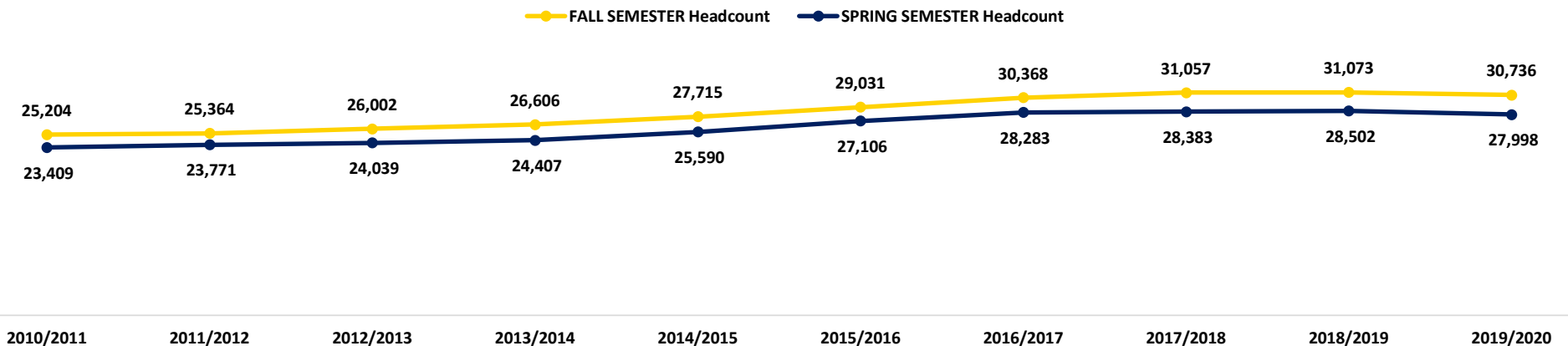
