

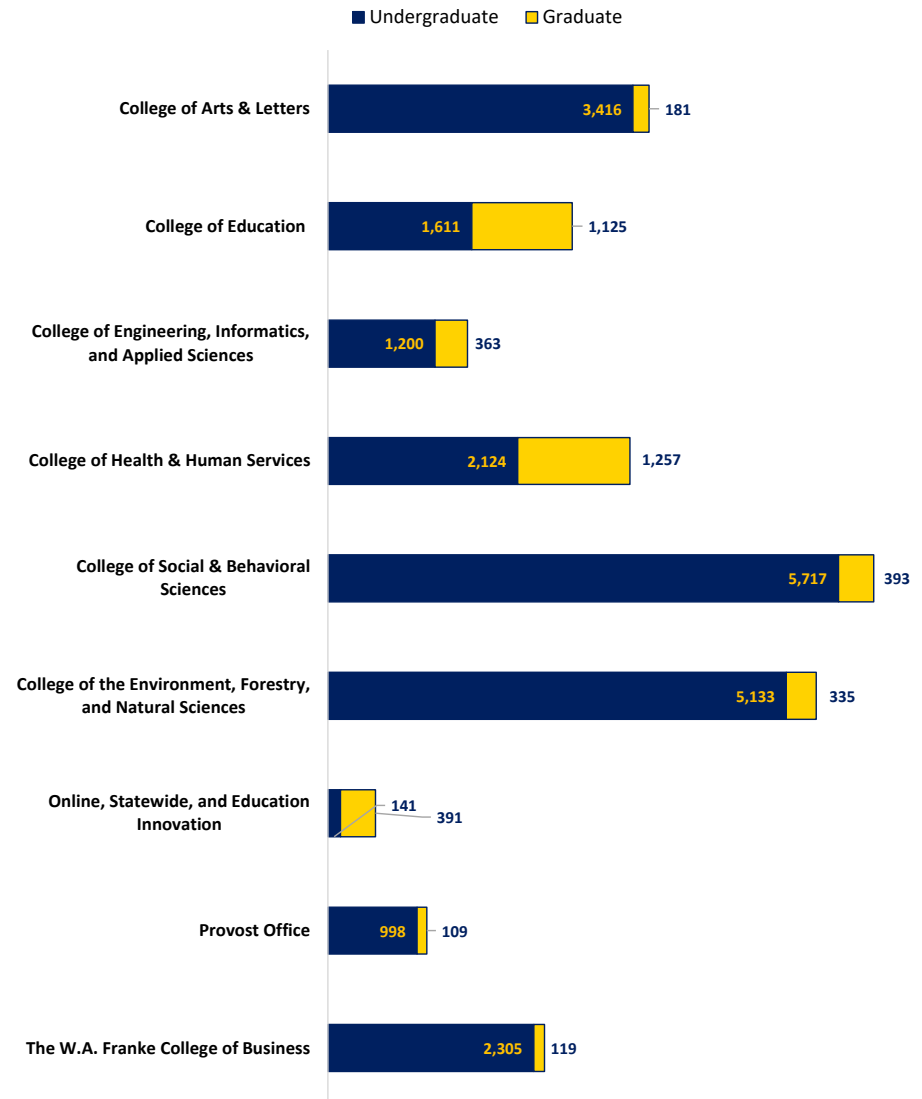

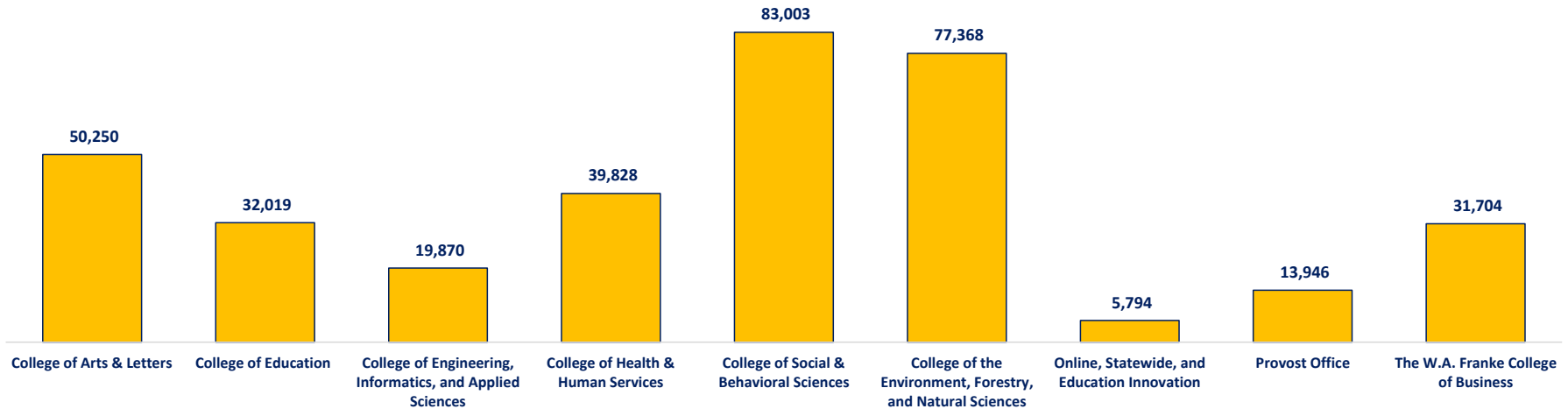
Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) by College

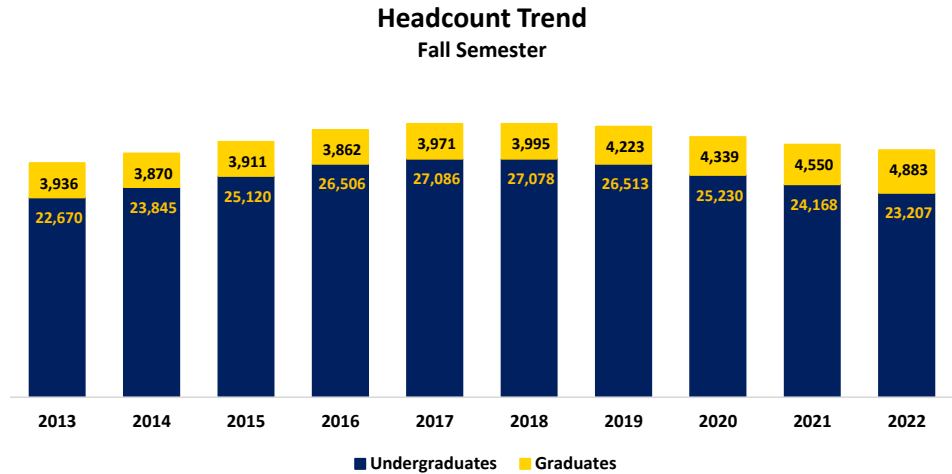
**Student Credit Hours (SCH) by College  
Fall 2022**



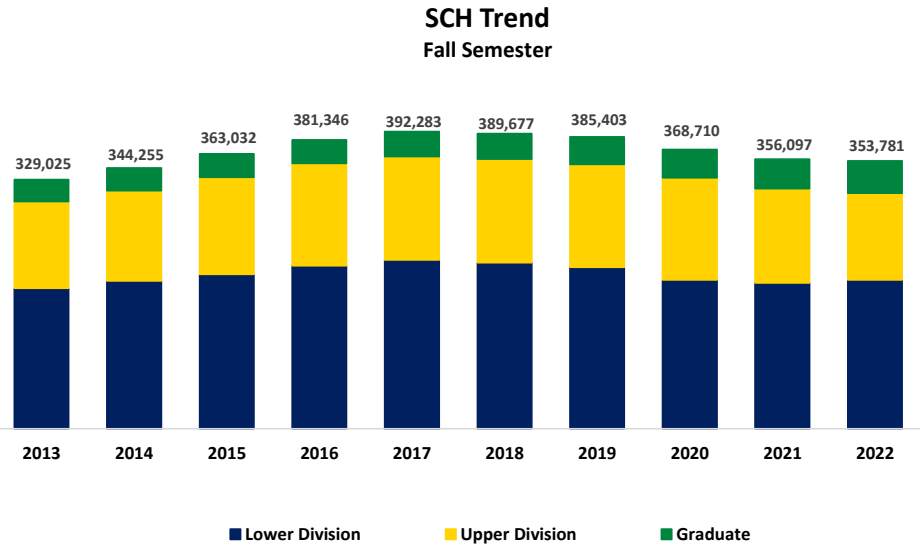

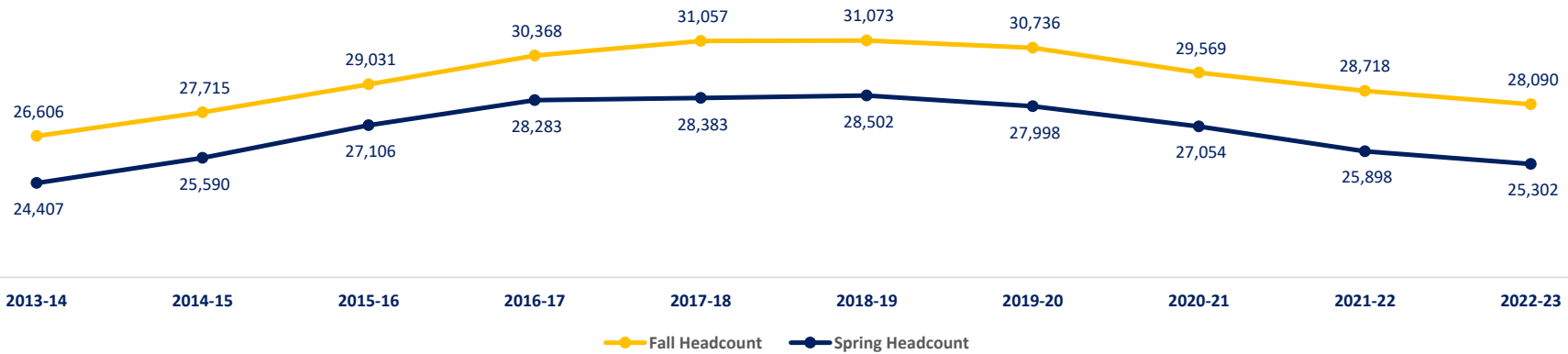
