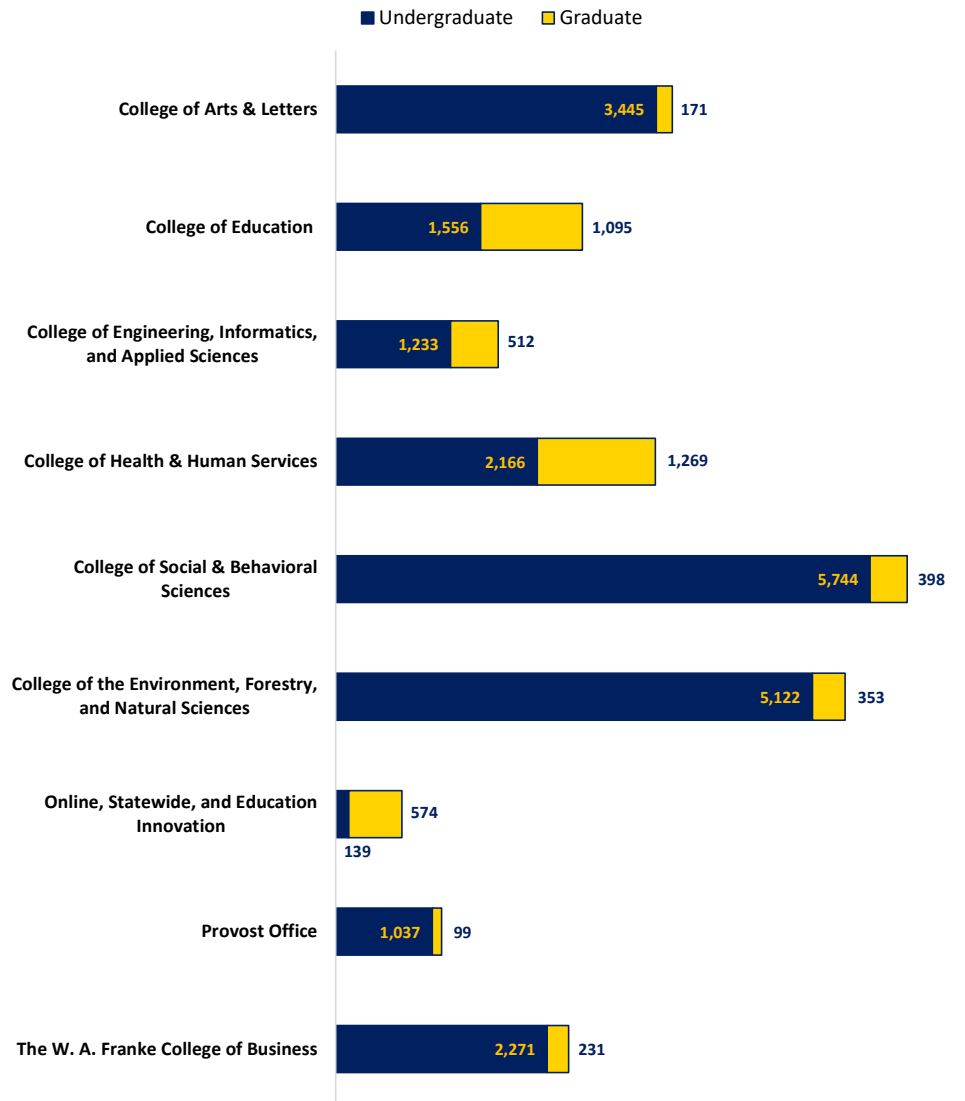

Fall 2023



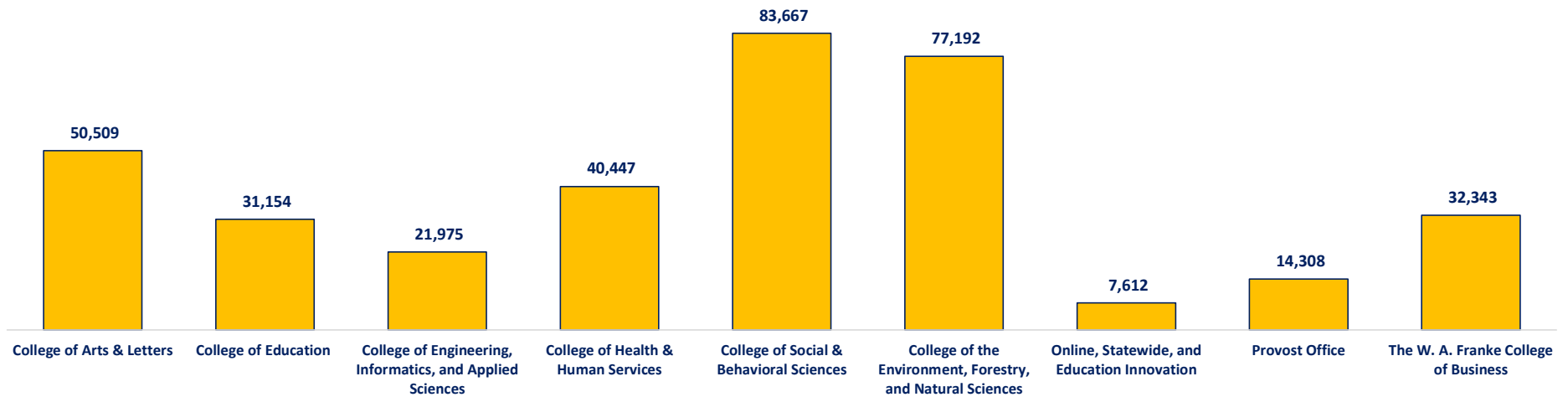

Fall 2023



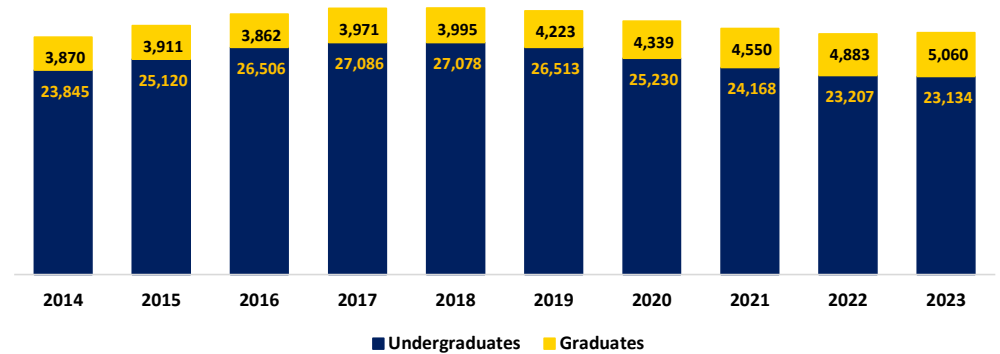

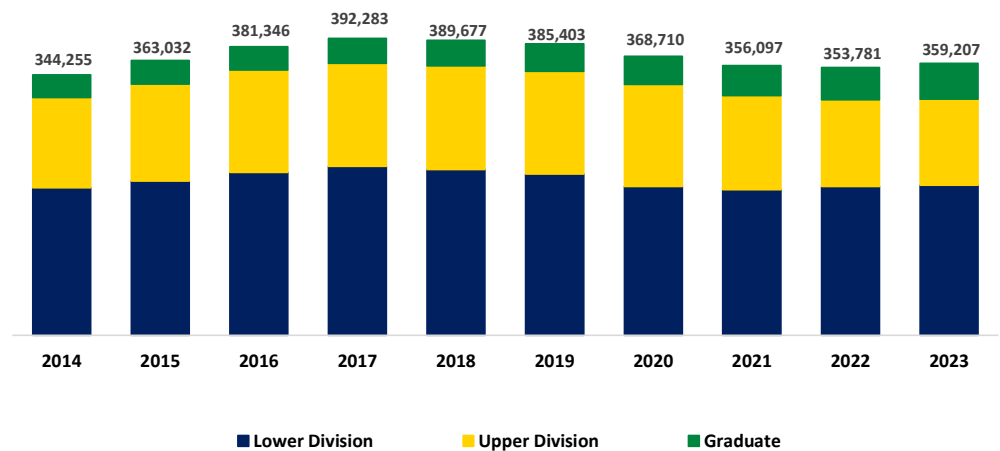

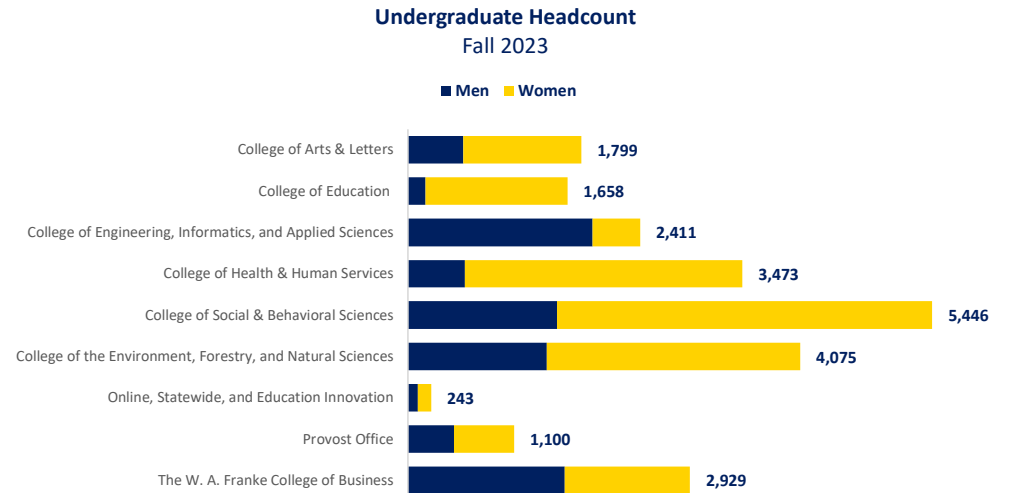
### SCH Trend Fall Semester



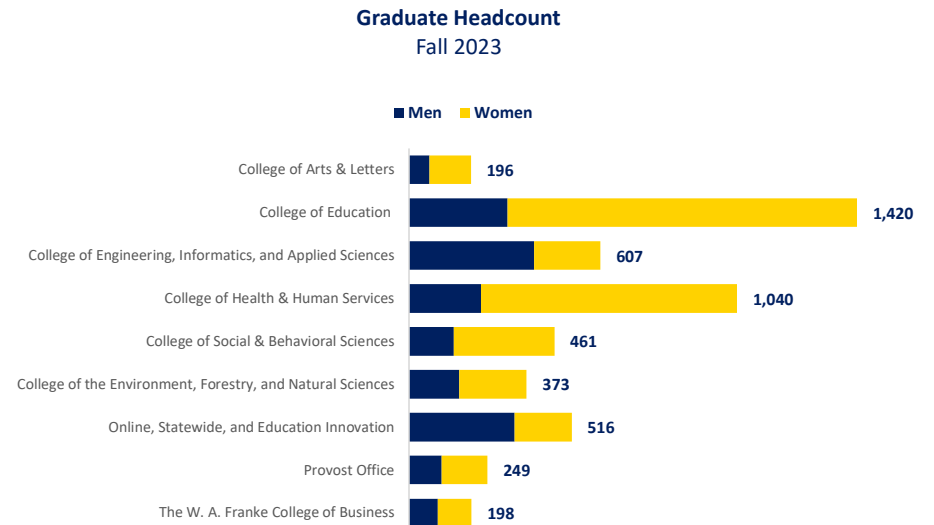

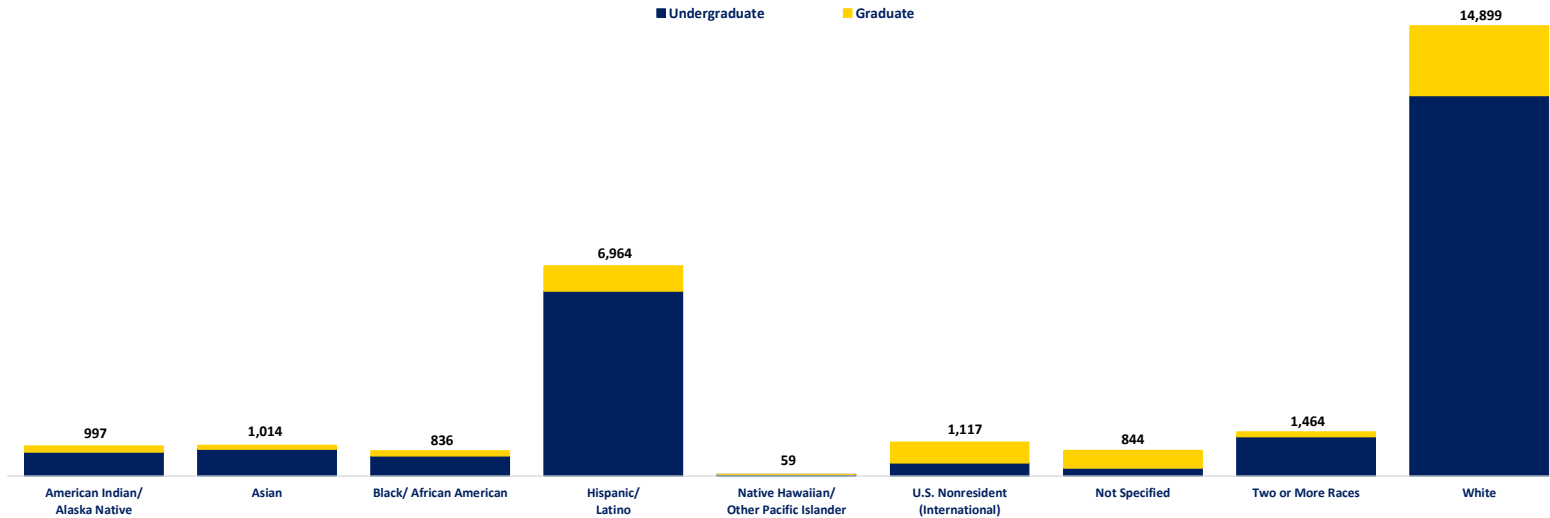

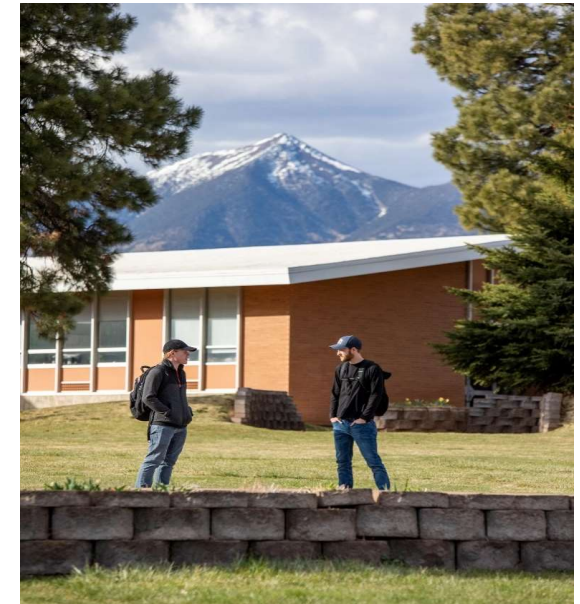

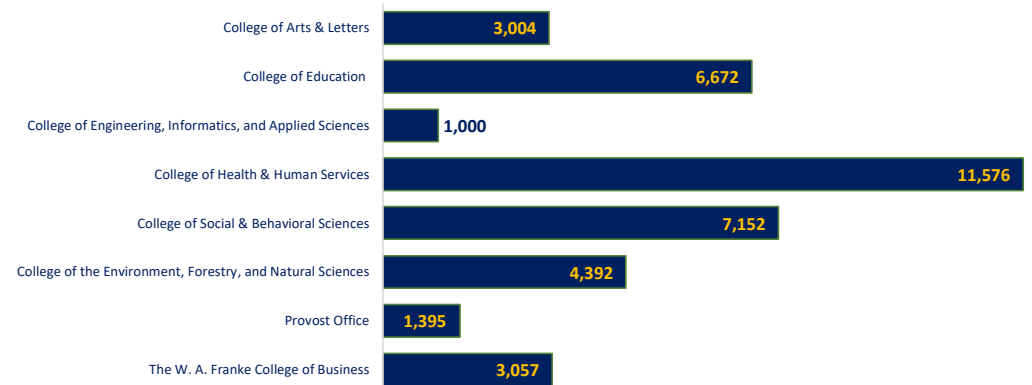

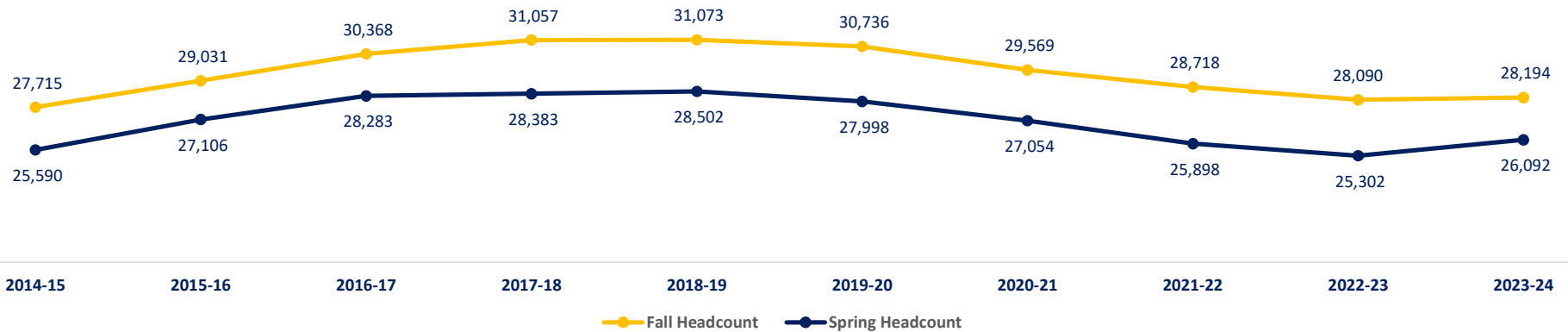
