Ingress, facilitate parking as follows:

ADA/VIP to P66 via E/B McConnell from Pine Knoll/McConnell is possible. If it is too busy, direct all traffic south on Pine Knoll.

Plain-talk procedures are in effect: no ten codes. Keep all transmissions brief and professional. Callsigns are your last name and or your location e.g. "Smith at Pine Knoll/McConnell"

Talkgroup Configuration:
Patch NAUPD Main and NAUPD Event 1. This will be the Skydome Patch. Also patch NAUPD Event 2, FPD Event 3, Facilities Main, and Parking Main. This will be the Traffic Patch. Do not allow ACJIS transactions on Event 2. Use NAU PD Main or Info only.

In the event of a Contingency Team activation, contingency team members will switch radios to NAUPD main and respond as directed from IC. If the emergency is inside the Skydome, the patch between Main and Event 1 will remain in place. If the emergency is outside the Skydome, the patch will be cut so the emergency can have a dedicated communications channel.

Communications Unit Work Assignments

- 1. Maintain police dispatch services for assigned units.
- 2. Configure radio resources IAW the Communications Plan
- Create a Master Event for recording event notes including timestamps, lot counts, and other notes as directed
 Create a new event for each unique report of crime, injury, or other situations which would normally require a DR
- For incidents at the Skydome, assure response of event officers. Dispatch all other incidents to patrol
 Medical incidents at the Skydome: dispatch pre-staged GMT resources

- 7. Medical incidents away from the Skydome: dispatch IAW normal procedures
 8. Do not allow ACJIS transactions on Event 2 due to no LE talkgroups in the patch. ACJIS transactions are permitted on NAUPD Main, Event 1, and Info



General Safety Reminders

- Traffic vests are required whenever operating in a TCP role. Wands/Flashlights are mandatory if dark
- Do not physically place yourself in front of non-compliant vehicles. Report CYMBALS and DOT!
- Be sure you are taking measures to sustain yourself. Keep hydrated and take meals proactively
- Gloves, hats, coats, and eye protection are mandatory for personnel working outside. Facial protection (ski masks, balaclavas, etc.) and weather-proof boots are also approved for use

DOME EVACUATION BRIEFING / PLAN

If an alarm sounds, it is a true alarm (Fire panel monitors have validated the emergency) or an emergency requiring evacuation has been identified:

- 1. The Skydome Division supervisor will radio the Incident Commander and advise of the situation
- 2. The Contingency Team members not assigned to the President or Pine Knoll and Lonetree will be activated and respond to assist with evacuation. The members assigned to the President and Pine Knoll and Lonetree will continue those duties assisting the President evacuate and stay informed and facilitating egress off campus at Pine Knoll and Lonetree.
- 3. All persons on the field level will be ushered out the north doors. ADA overflow exists on the field level and will need assistance.
- 4. All persons in the standard will be directed to the nearest exits on the concourse level. ADA seats exist in the middle of both the east and west concourse and will need assistance.

 5. Officers assigned to the southeast and northwest positions will report to the mezzanine (middle) level and assist the ADA guests seated in the ADA seats along the railing onto the elevator and up to the concourse
- 6. Emergency response (additional law enforcement, medical, fire or bomb squad) will be directed to respond on McConnell Drive into the horseshoe (lot 67) or on San Francisco St. (from the north) and park on the roadway along the east side of the Skydome.
- 7. Shuttle Services will run shuttle services out of lot 66A to both lot 62 and 96B avoiding the road closures.
- 8. Move guests away from the dome to the parking lots, East practice fields or closed roadways.
- 9. Once persons have been evacuated, Skydome units and Contingency members will assist dome staff supervisors and conduct a final sweep.
- 10. Non-certified workers will assist Skydome staff outside not allowing re-entry of evacuated persons
- 11. Once sweep is complete, inside units will maintain security with only essential involved personnel allowed back in.

Once a building and/or area have been evacuated law enforcement will:

- 1. Limit access to the Skydome. Unless approved by the IC, only essential personnel will be allowed in.
- Protect buildings and property affected by the evacuation. Lock shop to possibly re-key entries.
 Re-entry will only be permitted when deemed safe by the IC via the appropriate authority.

- Once the building and/or area has been approved for safe re-entry by the IC and EOC:

 1. The University public shall be informed of re-entry status (if necessary, why re-entry is not possible at a given time) through the same media channels as the evacuation was announced.
- 2. Return of evacuees to the evacuated area(s) will be according to the same considerations, coordination, and control as the original evacuation

Specific Re-entry Considerations:

- 1. The threat causing the evacuation is completely over?
- 2. Only a safe level or no contamination exists?
- 3. Buildings have been inspected and determined to be safe?
- 4. Numbers of those who require special accommodations to return has been calculated?
- 5. Arrangements to coordinate traffic control and movement of persons are complete?




