

NAU Timely Warning / Crime Alert (CA# 2024-09)

Surreptitious Viewing

On October 2nd, 2024, at 1pm, a female resident of a Campus Living Community reported an unknown suspect placed an iPhone over a partition while she was taking a shower. Based on the actions of the suspect, it is likely the suspect was taking video or photographs of the resident while she showered. Once noticed, the suspect fled the restroom in an unknown direction.

The resident was able to describe the suspect as white and likely male. She described the suspect's phone as an iPhone that was silver in color with a black case.

The identity and whereabouts of the suspect are unknown.

NAUPD urges you to call 911 immediately if you notice suspicious activity. Delays in reporting decrease our ability to solve these crimes. If you have any information on this or any other crime, please contact the NAU Police Department immediately. Always call 911 if there is an emergency or situation in progress. Call if you can, text if you can't. For non-emergencies or late reports, dial 928-523-3611.

SECURITY TIPS

- Secure open or unlocked doors and windows in your room.
- Report all suspicious activity to the police department.
- Always lock your door, even when using a common restroom/shower.
- Do not prop open doors or allow unescorted guests into your building.
- Be aware of your surroundings. Know where you are and where you are going.
- Avoid using headphones in both ears so you can be alert to your surroundings.
- Trust your instincts. If a situation feels unsafe, remove yourself from it.
