

**NAU Timely Warning / Crime Alert (CA# 2024-10)****Surreptitious Viewing**

On November 11, 2024, at 3:30 a.m., a female resident of a Campus Living Community reported an unknown suspect placed an iPhone over a partition while she was using the restroom. Based on the actions of the suspect, it is likely the suspect was taking video or photographs of the resident. The suspect fled the restroom, entered an adjacent stairwell, and descended. The suspect's current whereabouts and identity are unknown.

The resident described the suspect as having a darker skin tone. The suspect's iPhone was black and was contained in a clear case.

NAUPD urges you to call 911 immediately if you notice suspicious activity. Delays in reporting decrease our ability to solve these crimes. If you have any information on this or any other crime, please contact the NAU Police Department immediately. Always call 911 if there is an emergency or situation in progress. Call if you can, text if you can't. For non-emergencies or late reports, dial 928-523-3611.

**SECURITY TIPS**

- Secure open or unlocked doors and windows in your room.
- Report all suspicious activity to the police department.
- Always lock your door, even when using a common restroom/shower.
- Do not prop open doors or allow unescorted guests into your building.
- Be aware of your surroundings. Know where you are and where you are going.
- Avoid using headphones in both ears so you can be alert to your surroundings.
- Trust your instincts. If a situation feels unsafe, remove yourself from it.
