

NAU Timely Warning / Crime Alert (CA# 2025-01)

Surreptitious Viewing (ARS 13-3019 Class 5 Felony)

On February 10, 2025, at 10:27 pm., a male resident of a Campus Living Community reported an unknown suspect placed a cell phone under a partition while he was taking a shower. Based on the actions of the suspect, it is likely the suspect was taking video or photographs of the resident. Once the victim observed the phone the suspect quickly fled the restroom. The suspect's current whereabouts and identity are unknown.

The resident described the suspect as most likely female, having a lighter skin tone with black acrylic nails. The suspect's phone had a blue case.

NAUPD urges you to call 911 immediately if you notice suspicious activity. Delays in reporting decrease our ability to solve these crimes. If you have any information on this or any other crime, please contact the NAU Police Department immediately. Always call 911 if there is an emergency or situation in progress. Call if you can, text if you can't. For non-emergencies or late reports, dial 928-523-3611.

SAFETY TIPS

- Report all suspicious activity to the police department immediately.
- Secure open or unlocked doors and windows in your room.
- Always lock your door, even when using a common restroom/shower.
- Do not prop open doors or allow unescorted guests into your building.
- Be aware of your surroundings. Know where you are and where you are going.
- Avoid using headphones in both ears so you can be alert to your surroundings.
- Trust your instincts. If a situation feels unsafe, remove yourself from it.
