Surreptitious Viewing (ARS 13-3019 Class 5 Felony)

On August 24, 2025 at approximately 9:45 PM, Northern Arizona University Police Department (NAUPD) received a report of a surreptitious viewing incident involving a student. The incident occurred earlier in the day at approximately 5:30 PM in a campus residential facility.

The reporting party stated that while showering in a communal restroom, they observed a mobile phone placed face-up beneath the divider of an adjacent stall. The phone's screen appeared to be directed toward them, and a dim reflection was visible. The individual responsible was not identified, and only a light-skinned hand was seen. No further description was available, and the suspect's direction of travel is unknown.

NAUPD urges you to call 911 immediately if you notice suspicious activity. Delays in reporting decrease our ability to solve these crimes. If you have any information on this or any other crime, please contact the NAU Police Department immediately. Always call 911 if there is an emergency or situation in progress. Call if you can, text if you can't. For non emergencies or late reports, call 928-523-3611

SAFETY TIPS

- Report all suspicious activity to the police department immediately.
- Secure open or unlocked doors and windows in your room.
- Always lock your door, even when using a common restroom/shower.
- Do not prop open doors or allow unescorted guests into your building.
- Be aware of your surroundings. Know where you are and where you are going.
- Avoid using headphones in both ears so you can be alert to your surroundings.
- Trust your instincts. If a situation feels unsafe, remove yourself from it.
