NAU's BSW is available in person in Flagstaff and Yuma, or Online. NAU offers a 2 year Master of Social Work and a 1 year Master of Social Work – Advanced Standing. Admission to the MSW – Advanced Standing requires a gpa of 3.30 in a BSW from a CSWE-accredited program within 5 years of admission OR completion within 10 years plus 5 years human service experience.
