



GRADUATE COURSE REPEAT ENROLLMENT FORM

- Graduate students do not normally repeat courses. If a grade of "C", "D", or "F" is received in a graduate course, students may repeat that course. In cases dictated by accreditation, students in those programs may not be eligible for grade replacement.
- Graduate students may repeat for grade replacement up to 9 credits total in their graduate career. Students are limited to repeating any given course for grade replacement two times, for three total attempts. The higher of these grades will be used in GPA calculation.
- Units earned for repeated courses may only be used once to fulfill graduation requirements.
