

## Louie How to Access and Read Your Academic Advisement Report Transcript

Let's take a look at how to access and read your Academic Advisement Report. Sometimes also known as the Academic Requirements Report.

The Academic Advisement Report is a fantastic tool that will help you keep track of every requirement you need to complete your degree at NAU. It also keeps track of which courses you've taken, and lets you know which requirements they complete!

First, let's take a look at how to find your Academic Advisement Report in LOUIE. Navigate to [nau.edu/louie](http://nau.edu/louie).

Click Log into Louie and log in with your NAU Credentials.

Here you will see your student homepage.

Click the "Academic Progress" tile.

The first thing you should see is your Academic Advisement Report.

At first glance, reading this page can be tricky.

If you find a section that is opened up, the arrow is pointing downwards, and you find text that reads "Not Satisfied," it means you have not completed that particular requirement yet.

If the section is closed up, the arrow pointing towards the category, or it says "Satisfied," it means that a class you have taken or a class that you have enrolled in is completing the requirement.

Keep in mind that this is also keeping tabs on the courses you enroll in for future semesters, so while it may label a category as "satisfied," you won't truly have it completed until you pass the class!
