

Louie How to Determine if a Class Has a Pre or Co Requisite Transcript

Let's take a look at how to determine if a class has pre- or co- requisites.

As a refresher, a "Prerequisite" is something that needs to be completed before you can take the course. For example, MAT 136 (Calculus I) has a prerequisite of MAT 125, meaning you would need to complete MAT 125 before you can take MAT 136.

A "corequisite" is something you must complete at the same time as another course. For example, GLG 112 (Geologic Disasters) has a corequisite of GLG 112L, meaning you have to enroll in both classes during the same semester.

You can determine if a class has any requisites through the Louie "Class Search" function.

When searching for a class, simply click the link on the left-hand side, under the "Section Session" category. If you hover over this link, you will see a small pop-up that says "View Details".

Once you've selected the session in question, scroll down to the section that says "Enrollment Information".

If a course has any requisites, you will find a line that says "Enrollment Requirements". This line will let you know what the requisites to enroll in this class are, and if those requisites are pre- or co-.

If you've completed those requirements or have the required co-requisite in your shopping cart or you're already enrolled, you should be able to enroll in the class.

Please note that if you attempt to enroll in a class where you do not meet all the pre- or co-requisites, the enrollment likely will not go through, and you will be informed that you are missing requisites for the course.
