

## Louie Reserved Seats Transcript

Let's take a look at how to check for reserved seats when enrolling in classes using LOUIE.

Seat reservations are signaled with a red letter "R." This symbol will appear next to the number of seats available for a given course.

If you see this red "R," you'll want to check and make sure you are a part of the student group that qualifies to enroll in this particular section.

The easiest way to check which groups the seats are being reserved for is by looking at the details of the particular section.

To do this, simply select the blue "Section Session" link found on the left-hand side of the enrollment details. Hovering over the link will give you a little note that says "View Details."

Scroll down until you find the section labeled "Reserved Seats." Here, you will find:

- Which student group the seats are reserved for
- The total number of seats that are reserved
- And the number of reserved seats that are still available

If you are not a part of the student group listed, you will not be able to enroll in any of the seats being held.

If a course still has open seats but they are being reserved, you can still waitlist yourself into the class. In the event that the seat reservations are removed before the course is filled, waitlisted students will have a chance to get those seats.
