

Louie Searching for Liberal Studies and Diversity Courses Transcript

Let's take a look at searching for Liberal Studies and Diversity courses in LOUIE. Liberal Studies and Diversity courses are required for all degree plans. Thankfully, there is a very easy way to search for these courses in the Louie Class Search.

From the LOUIE Class Search, find the section titled "Requirement Designation" and select the drop-down menu.

Here, you should see options that reflect each of the Liberal Study categories. For example, Aesthetic and Humanistic Inquiry, Cultural Understanding, or Science and Applied Science.

You may also notice that for each of these categories, there is an option to search for specific Liberal Study and Diversity combinations. You often hear these referred to as "double dipping" courses.

Let's click social political worlds as an example. Click "Search", and you will find every single class, from every subject, that meets that requirement.

You can always double-check to see if a class is completing a Liberal Study or Diversity requirement too by selecting the "Section Session" link on the left-hand side that accompanies the course in question.

Scroll down to the section that says "Enrollment Information". If a class provides a Liberal Study and/or Diversity requirement, there will be a line in this section that reads, "Requirement Designation," and next to it, you will see which Liberal Study or Diversity this course counts as.
