Cisco Secure Client VPN Installing on a Mac OS X Machine

In this video, I am going to walk you through how to install the Cisco Secure VPN on your Mac OS X machine.

First, open a web browser and navigate to NAU's software website at nau.edu/software. For this example, I am going to use Google Chrome. Scroll down to the "Software Services" Section. Click "Software Downloads". If prompted, log in with your NAU Credentials. In the search bar under "Software" type "Cisco". From the list that populates click "CiscoSecure VPN for macOS". Then click, "Download Cisco Secure VPN for macOS". The software will download to your machine. Find the download, and double click the file. This will open a finder window with the software file in it. Double click the "Cisco Secure Client macOS" file. A popup box will appear, click "Continue". Read through the Supplemental End User License Agreement. If you agree, click "Continue". Another popup box will appear, and you can read the entire license agreement here. Then click "Agree". Click "Continue". Now click "Install". You may be prompted to type in your computer password to allow the install. Do so and click "Install Software". Click "Close".
