

## **Searching for General Studies and Liberal Studies Class Transcript**

Beginning in Fall 2025, NAU is offering a re-envisioned general education program called General Studies. Prior to Fall 2025, the general education program is called Liberal Studies. Let's take a look at searching for General Studies or Liberal Studies classes. Thankfully, there is a very easy way to search for these classes in the Louie Class Search.

If you want to find a General Studies or Liberal Studies class, go to the drop-down labeled Course Attribute. From here, you will need to select General Studies or Liberal studies, depending on your catalog year and general education program. If you are unsure which to select, hover over the additional information icon to the right of the Course Attribute drop down menu. After you have selected General Studies or Liberal Studies, you will see the specific categories available in the Course Attribute Value drop down, for course selection. Let's click, Social and Political Worlds as an example. Click Search and you will find classes offered that term which meet the Social and Political Worlds requirement.

You may also notice that for each of these categories, there is an option to search for specific General Studies and Inclusive Perspective combinations. You often hear these referred to as double dipping classes.

You can always double-check to see if a class is completing a General Studies requirement by selecting the Section Session link on the left-hand side that accompanies the class in question. Scroll down to the section that says Enrollment Information. If a class meets a General Studies and/or Liberal Studies requirement, there will be a line in this section that reads, Class Attributes and next to it, you will see which General Studies and/or Liberal Studies this class counts as.
