

## Tableau Dashboards Overview

### Obtaining Access:

University employees who need access to the dashboards to support their job functions may obtain access by completing the following:

### Dashboard Development Processes:

NAU's Tableau Workgroup identifies and builds dashboards to address the most critical data needs in support of strategic priorities. All Campus Leadership dashboards utilize thoroughly validated and tested data tables from the university data warehouse. By using a common source for our dashboards we aim to provide the most consistent and accurate data for campus. Dashboards are updated daily unless otherwise specified. Official dashboards are integrated with NAU's Data Cookbook tool.

### Campus Leadership Dashboards:

Admissions/Admissions Application Summary: Provides year-to-date summary comparisons of the admission application funnel for degree-seeking applicant populations, including undergraduate, graduate, and international. Data can be viewed by student campus and admit term.

Admissions/Daily Admissions Dashboard: Provides year-to-date detailed comparisons of the admission application funnel for all applicant populations, including undergraduate, graduate, and international. Data can be viewed by student campus and admit term.

Analysis & Retention/Undergraduate Cohort Retention & Graduation: Provides retention and graduation counts and rates by undergraduate cohort from Fall 1994 to present. Users can compare rates for particular populations and/or by a variety of academic preparation variables.

Enrollment/Daily Enrollment: Provides daily enrollment headcounts for the active enrollment term compared to enrollment at three points in time the prior year: the same relative day, first day of term, and census day.

Enrollment/Enrollment and Eligibility: Provides daily enrollment headcounts and eligible to enroll headcounts for the active enrollment term compared to enrollment at three points in time the prior year: the same relative day, first day of term, and census day.

Course Management/Course Grade Analysis: Displays course-level D, F, and W and grade distribution information by college, division, term and class section. Also provides average GPA by course and by student. *Data are based upon a frozen snapshot of final grade data taken 4 weeks after the end of each major semester.*

Course Management/Course Scheduling Analytics: Displays course enrollment (class capacity) information for courses across selected term enrollment events. Users can compare enrollment capacity, enrollment total, and percent utilization by course, department, college, level, etc. Class Enrollment Changes, Trends and Variances are also available.

Sponsored Projects/Sponsored Projects – Principal Investigator: Provides Principal Investigators with budget detail regarding their grant awards.

Sponsored Projects/Sponsored Projects – Deans' Access: Provides College Deans with budget detail regarding grant awards within their Academic College.

Sponsored Projects/Sponsored Projects – Fund Mgr/Post Award Access: Provides Fund Managers and Post Award Administrators with budget detail regarding institutional grant awards.
