Academic Social Norming

- 1 Misperceptions of Norms
 - "Everyone skips class."
 - "No one uses office hours."
 - "C's get degrees."
 - "No one works as hard as I do."
- 2 Intervention Goals
 - Normalize help-seeking behaviors
 - Transform attitudes around academics
 - Utilize statistics for "just in time" messaging

- 3 Intervention Strategy
 - Academic Behaviors Survey
 - Campus-wide campaign
 - Faculty and staff collaboration
 - Discussion activities
- 4 Anticipated Outcomes
 - Increased use of academic resources
 - Positive perceptions of NAU students' academic behaviors
 - Increased participation in help-seeking behaviors.

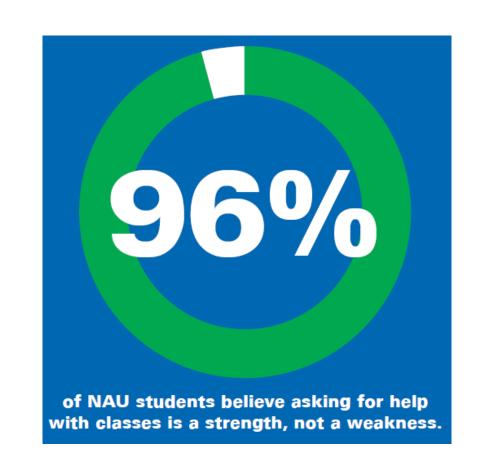

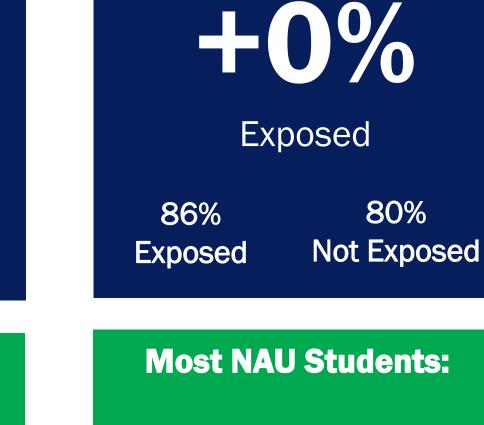

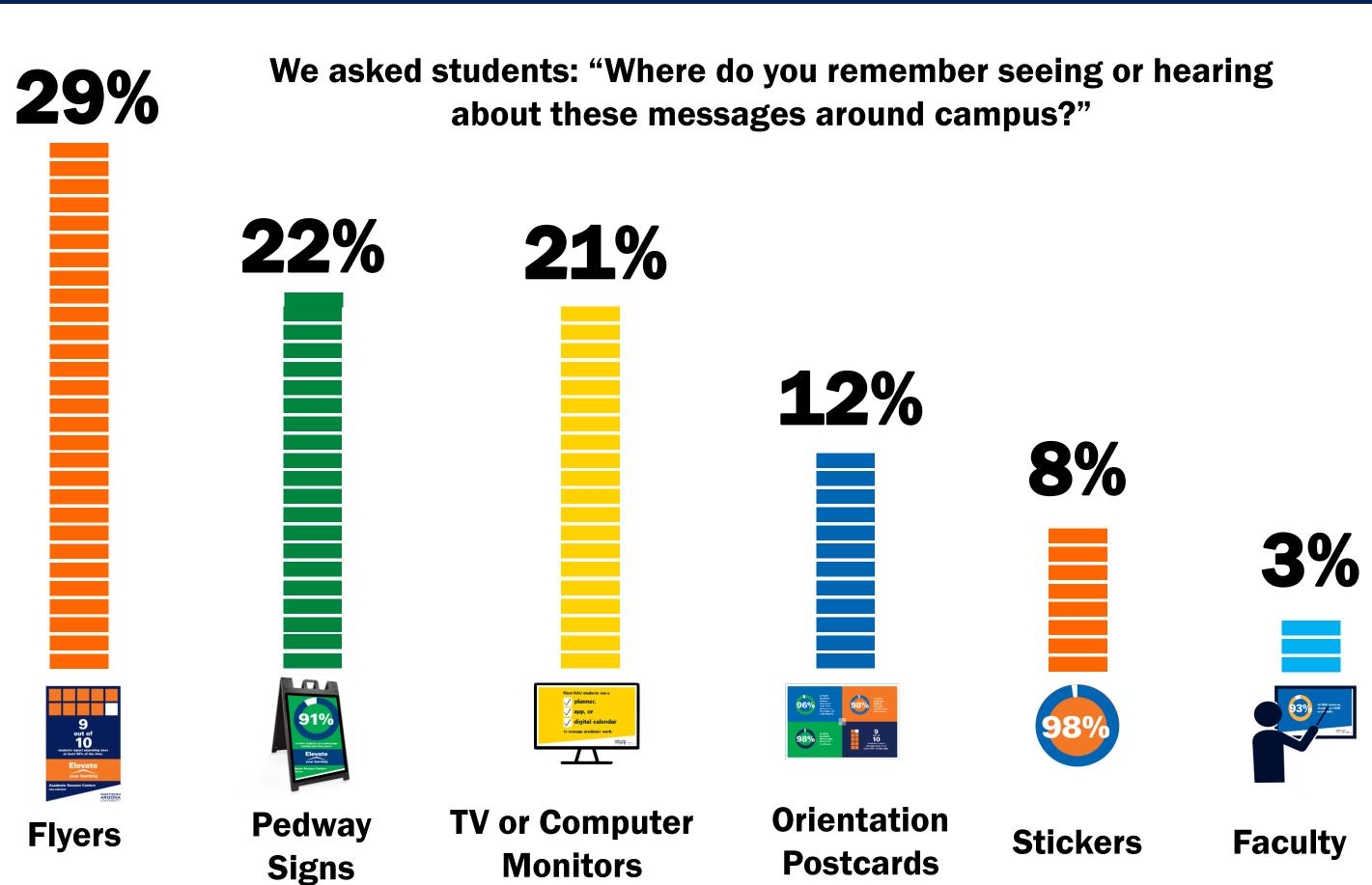


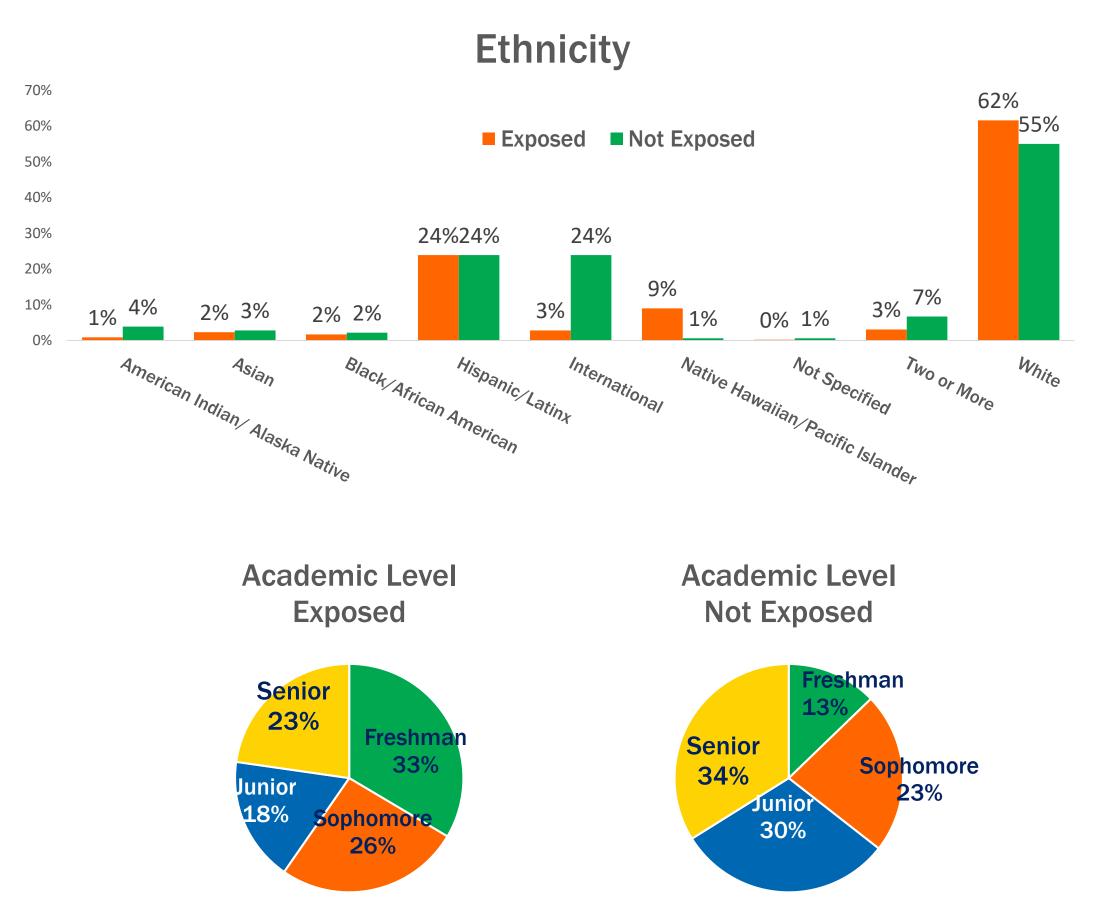


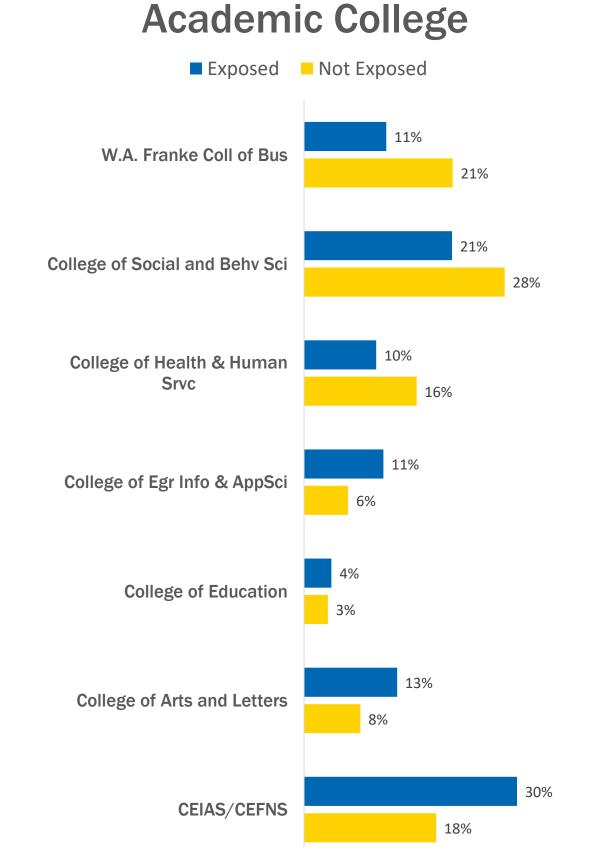


Campaign Exposure

Next Steps

- Evaluate impact of campaign on students' perceptions and behaviors based on G.P.A.
- Compare responses of students who took both versions of the survey, and evaluate if behaviors or perceptions changed.
- Strategize how to improve learning strategies for deficit areas, such as completing multiple drafts for a paper, study time, and starting assignments days before the due date.
- Increase faculty use of norming materials.
- Review and address barriers to seeking academic support.
