Response Analysis of NAU Student Feedback Surveys

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Background

Northern Arizona University started using the CoursEval product for university-wide student course evaluations during the 2014-15 Winter semester with a set of 16 questions. The Student Feedback Survey Working Group was formed in 2015 to develop a new set of 10 questions to be used on the surveys starting Spring 2017 by gathering input from faculty, administrators and students. The purpose of this project is to determine how the change in questions has affected response rates by looking at Fall 2016 results versus Fall 2018 results and to take a deep dive into response rates by course attributes for Fall 2018 results.

Fall 2016 Questions

Instructor-Based Questions

- My instructor explains difficult material clearly.
- My instructor communicates at a level that I can understand.
- My Instructor makes requirements clear.
- My instructor identifies relationships between and among topics.
- My instructor establishes a climate of respect.
- My instructor is available to me on matters pertaining to the course.
- My instructor respects diverse talents.
- My instructor gives assignments that are stimulating to me.
- My instructor encourages me to develop new viewpoints.
- My instructor creates an atmosphere in which ideas can be exchanged freely.
- My instructor arouses my curiosity.
- My instructor stimulates my creativity.

Fall 2018 Questions

Instructor-Based Questions

- The instructor provides constructive feedback on assignments.
- The instructor answers questions and concerns in a timely manner.
- The instructor shows respect for students.

Course-Based Questions

- Course requirements were stated clearly in the syllabus.
- The course was organized in a way that helped me learn.
- The assignments helped me understand the subject more clearly.
- The grading criteria for each assignment were clear.
- The assignment that most contributed to my learning was...
- What suggestions do you have to improve this course...
- What did you like best about this course...

Comparison

The change in questions appears to be more streamlined. Questions went from mostly instructor-based to mostly course-based, and from 16 questions to 10 questions. One long-answer question changed to three long-answer questions. There is almost no overlap in questions – just one question about respect and one about clearness of course requirements.
