



AZ North Regional Event Facility Rules and FYI

Parking: Robot drop-off is from 4p- 8p on Wednesday and opens at 7:45am on Thursday morning. All loading/unloading takes place on the north side of the Skydome off of McConnell Drive. **Parking permits for Wednesday and Thursday will be available to teams and volunteers at pit check-in and must be displayed on vehicles all day Wednesday and Thursday.** Designated parking lots are open to the public on Friday and Saturday. Volunteers will be present during drop off to direct traffic. You may be redirected to stage in another lot until the loading area is clear. Vehicles with trailers should park in the designated area on the western edge of the lower half of lot P64 (across Pine Knoll Drive to the south of the Skydome) and pull through to only occupy two spaces. Please do not pull across parking stalls. All other vehicles and general parking will be in P66 directly to the south of the Skydome. All vehicles should park with their license plate facing the drive aisle (do not back into or pull through a stall unless your vehicle has license plate on both ends of the vehicle)

- **Food/Beverage Information:**

- **No outside food or drinks are allowed inside NAU Walkup Skydome. Team meals that are not purchased from the on-site concessions may not be eaten in the stands, concourse, or in the public areas of the building.** Bottled water will be permitted to be brought into the pit area. You may eat in the parking lot or outside the venue on the lawns. **No alcohol consumption is permitted.**
- Tailgating in the parking lot is only permitted in stalls along the perimeter of the lot. Please do not set up tents or tables in the parking lanes or in areas that may impact vehicular traffic. Please download the "Tailgating Zones" pdf from www.nau.edu/robotics for more information
- **No open flame cooking is permitted in the main Skydome parking lot.** Any open flame cooking must take place in designated areas. Please download the "Tailgating Zones" pdf from www.nau.edu/robotics for more information
- Dining options will be available for teams and the general public in the Skydome from Thursday morning through the close of the event. Please see the Eat-Stay-Play Information link at www.nau.edu/robotics for options, hours of operation, and pre-order opportunities.

- **Saturday Load-Out:** Please do not block the lanes waiting to unload at the North dock. Volunteers will be assisting with load-out traffic and team vehicles may be asked to stage in the main lot before being called down to the loading area.
