Flagstaff Urban Trail System (FUTS)

Miles of paved, dirt, and gravel trails link the city of Flagstaff from Lake Mary to Mt. Humphreys. Get out for a hike, bike, or jog and explore the beautiful Ponderosa Pine forests.

Flagstaff Lava Tubes

One of the many wonders of Flagstaff is the Lava Tubes. Left behind by the volcanic activity 700,000 years ago, this underground lava cave features 1.5 miles round trip hike through a tall rocky tube. Make sure to bring good shoes, a jacket, and plenty of flashlights.

The Arizona Trail

The Arizona Trail travels 800 miles from Utah to Mexico, passing through Flagstaff on the way. This trail features some beautiful sights, through hikers, and tons of cut off for short loops and local hikes here in Flagstaff.
