## Mormon Lake

Mormon Lake is the largest naturally formed lake in Arizona. During the warm months, trout, northern pike, and catfish can be caught in this stocked lake. Other activities in the area include camping, hiking, and boating.

## Lake Mary

Just 12 miles south of town is Lake Mary. This is a popular destination for fishing, power boating, canoeing, and kayaking. Upper Lake Mary is significantly larger than its twin, Lower Lake Mary. This is the perfect destination for a hot summer day.

## **Rivers**

Although Flagstaff does not have any active waterways, Northern Arizona is home to some beautiful rivers.

- The **San Juan River**, just north of the Arizona-Utah border has breath taking views, and fun white water for boaters of all levels.
- Located Southwest of Flagstaff, the Verde River offers great boating and fishing for recreationalists.
- The Colorado River may be the greatest treasure of Northern Arizona.
