1. **NAU Fleischer Scholar Program** - Fleischer Scholars is a high school program that assists high school students in making the transition to college with an emphasis on Entrepreneurial spirit. The program runs over the course of 5 weeks as a hybrid course. We will meet in person two times--to start and end the program. Scholars will complete weekly online work and meet virtually on Mondays and Thursdays 5pm-6pm to discuss and complete activities as a group.
