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The Kaibab Paiute Tribe Demographic Analysis

Introduction

This analysis of Kaibab Band of Paiute Indians was undertaken by the Arizona Rural Policy Institute (ARPI) a unit of the Center for Business Outreach in the W.A. Franke College of Business at Northern Arizona University for the planning department of the Kaibab Paiute Tribe. The ARPI has produced the Demographic Profile for Kaibab Paiute Tribe, with the latest information available from the 2015 American Community Survey (5-year estimates) American Indian and Alaska Native Tables. This document is provided to Arizona tribes as a product of the EDA University Center Grant provided by the EDA to the Center for Business Outreach at Northern Arizona University.

Since 2010 the American Community Survey (ACS) has been tasked with producing population, demographic and housing unit estimates for the United States on an annual and 5 year series basis. This analysis is entirely based the American Community Survey, 5-year estimate data for the period 2011 to 2015 and is annotated in the document as ACS 2011-2015 (5-year estimates). The 2011-2015 ACS 5-year estimates are based on data collected between January 2011 and December 2015. The data were used to analyze household income, poverty rates, employment, language use and household characteristics for Kaibab Paiute Tribe. Only the 5-year estimates are used as this is the only data that is provided for small population areas, the 5 year data represent the average characteristics over the 5-year period.

Demographic characteristics are outlined by three separate levels, the State of Arizona, Mohave County and the Kaibab Paiute Tribe. Comparisons between the State of Arizona, and Mohave County serve to provide further levels of comparison when examining demographic characteristics of the tribe. Mohave County was chosen for comparison as all Kaibab Paiute tribal lands and communities fall in Mohave County.

Appendix A contains the margin of error estimates to be used to calculate the estimates for the American Community Survey data.

Population

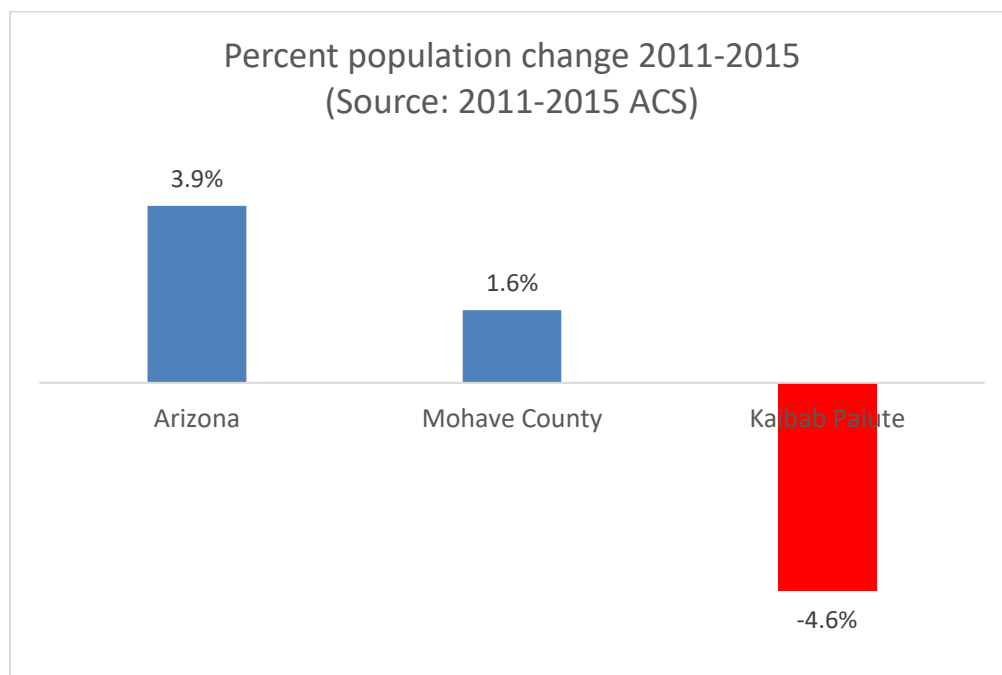
The population of Kaibab Paiute Tribe decreased by almost one-twentieth (-6.6%) from 2011 to 2015, data indicate there were 11 fewer tribal members in 2015. This decrease, however, may not truly reflect the actual change in the tribe between the census periods. The 2010 census is considered the official count, and accounts for only the population within the exterior boundaries of the tribal lands. Conversely, both the State (3.9%) and the County (1.6%) grew slowly between the period 2011 and 2015.

Gender

There are more females (60.2%) than males (39.8%) within the Kaibab Paiute Tribe. The percentage of males in Kaibab Paiute Tribe is lower than either the State (49.7%) or the County (49.4%), while females (60.2%) comprised a larger proportion of the population among the Kaibab Paiute than either the State (50.3%) or the County (50.6%).

Age

Kaibab Paiute Tribe is dominated by those under 19 years of age. The under-19 year population accounts for 37.6 percent of all tribal members, representing a far larger portion of tribal members than the same age group in the State (27.1%) or Mohave County (21.1%). The fact that more than one-third of the tribe is younger than 19 years of age carries with it some important policy implications. The large portion of younger tribal members influences the provision of health and educational services as well as poverty and workforce issues as well.

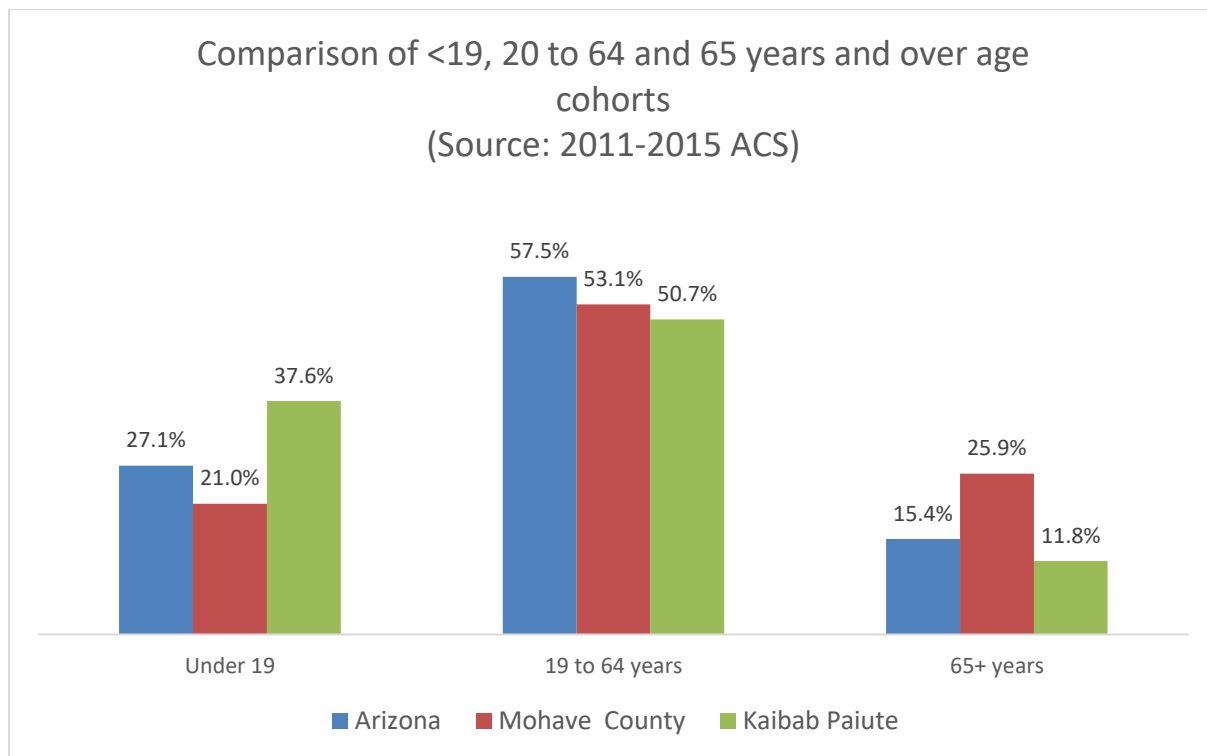

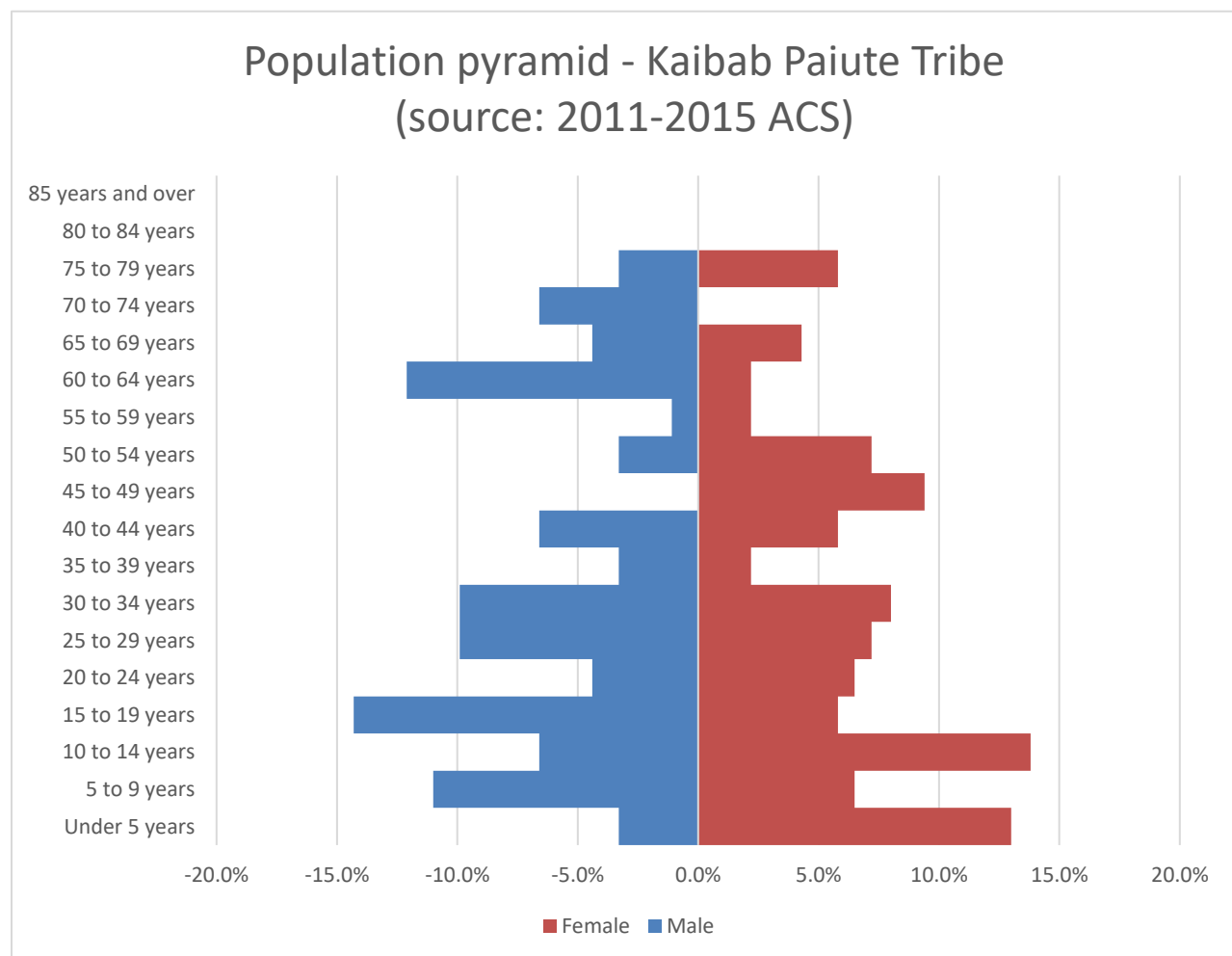
Figure 2. Age cohorts for Arizona, Mohave County & Kaibab Paiute Tribe 2011-2015

On the other hand, the tribe has fewer members who are 65 years or older. This age group, those who have retired and are out of the workforce, accounts for only 11.8 percent of tribal members when compared to 15.4 percent for the State and 25.9 percent for the County. These data indicate the overall youthful profile of the tribe. Finally, those age 19 to 64 years account for 50.7 percent of the tribal members, which compares favorably to the State (57.5%) and the County (58.3%). The large number of young tribal members will have an effect on the development of the tribal workforce in the future. See Table 3, and Figure 2. ACS Table S0101 was used to make Table 3.

A population pyramid, also called an age structure diagram, is a graphical illustration that shows the distribution of various age groups in a population (typically that of a country or region of the world), which forms the shape of a pyramid when the population is growing.

The population pyramid below (Figure 3) illustrates the difference between males and females for the 5 year age cohorts in the Kaibab Paiute Tribe. The under-19 age cohorts are somewhat symmetrical with fewer males under 5 years of age. The male population between 45 and 49 years of age are missing from the distribution as a females in the 70 to 74 year age range. At the top of the age pyramid there are more females than males. This is also a demographic reality as women tend to live longer than men. The age pyramid provides an illustrated snapshot of the age/gender structure of tribal members at the time of the 2011-2015 period.

Population Under 19 Years

Children under 19 years of age account for 37.6 percent of all tribal members. Thus, 32 males and 54 female tribal members are under age 19 – representing 35.2 percent of all males and 39.1 percent of all females under age 19. More males are in the cohort aged 5 to 9 (31.3%) than females (16.6%). The sex ratio favors males in the 15 to 19 year age range as 40.6 percent of all males fall in this age cohort, correspondingly, 35.3 percent of females are between the ages of 10 to 14. Median Age

The median age (the point where 50% of the population are above and 50% are below) for Kaibab Paiute tribal members is 29 years, with males slightly older at 30 years and females a younger at 28 years. The median age of tribal members is ten years younger than the State median (37years of age) and almost half the median age of the much-older County (49 years). This statistic serves once more to emphasize the relatively young age of tribal members. See Figure 4.

Figure 4. Median age in years 2011-2015

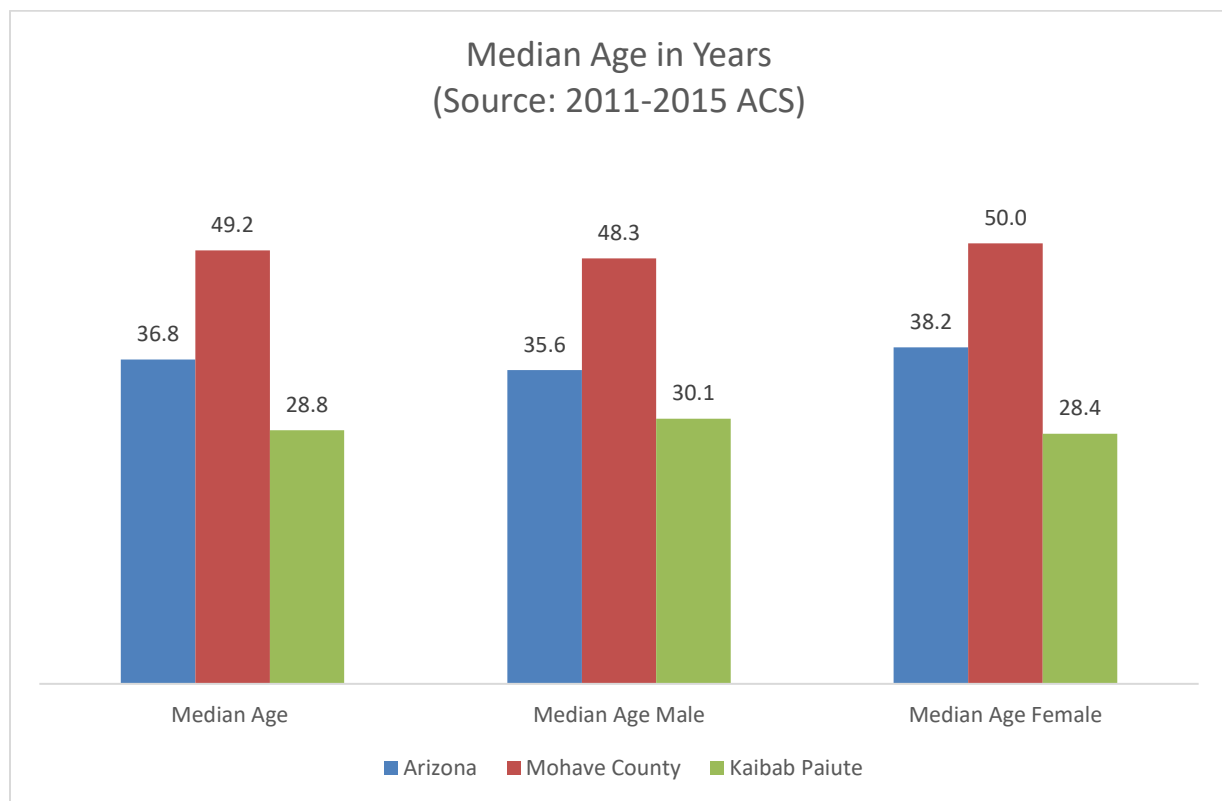

Race

Not surprisingly, the majority of Kaibab Paiute tribal members identify themselves as American Indian or Alaska Native alone (75%), while the remaining 25 percent are split between white alone, and multi-race persons. This stands in strong contrast to the State which is 78 percent white alone, and the County which is 89 percent white alone. See Table 6.

Ethnicity

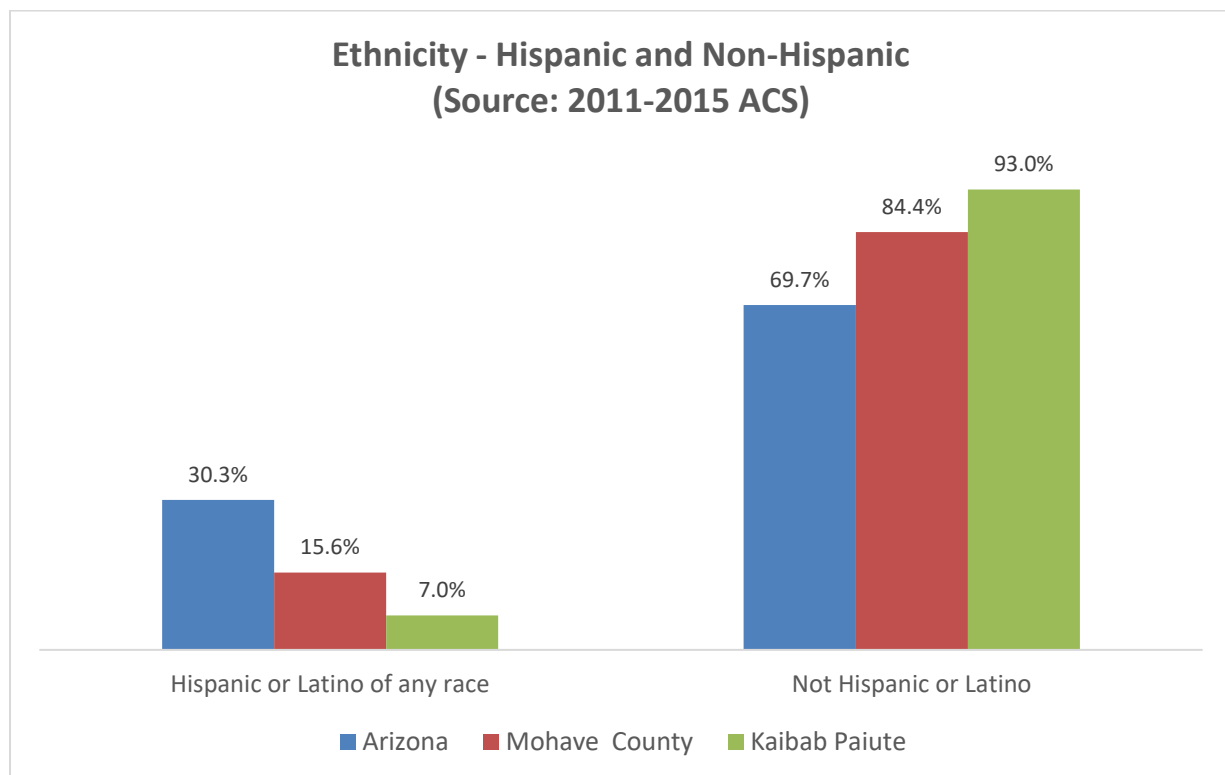
In terms of ethnicity, a small percentage (7.0%) of Kaibab Paiute tribal members self-identify as Hispanic or Latino. This is lower than the surrounding County where 15.6% identify themselves as Hispanic or Latino and much lower than the State where 30.3 percent identify themselves as Hispanic or Latino. 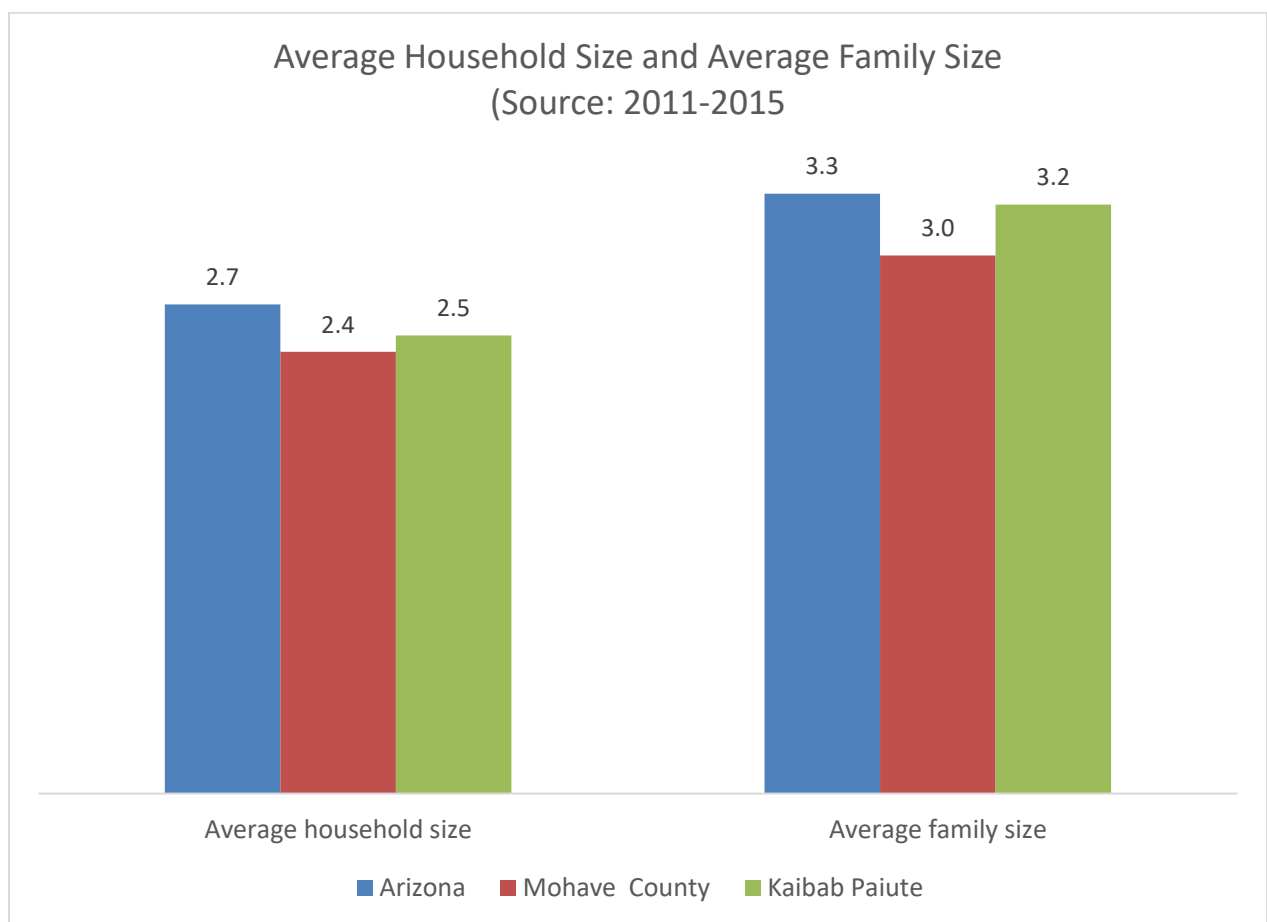
Figure 5. Ethnicity



Household Size

In 2011-2015, there were 91 households in the Kaibab Paiute Tribe, with an average household size of 2.5 persons and an average family size of 3.2 persons. The average household size of 2.5 persons is lower than the State average (2.7 persons) and the same as the County average (2.4 persons). The average family size for tribal members (3.2 persons) is slightly smaller than the State (3.3 persons) and higher than the County (3.0 persons). See Figure 6.

Households

The next section of the demographic profile focuses on households and their structure. The Census defines a “household” as a person or group of people who occupy a housing unit. The “householder” is a person in whose name the housing unit is owned, being bought, or rented. A “family household” consists of a householder and one or more people living together in the same household who are related to the householder by birth, marriage, or adoption — it may also include people unrelated to the householder. If the householder is married and living with his/her spouse, then the household is designated a “married-couple household.” The remaining types of family households not maintained by a married couple are designated by the sex of the householder. A “nonfamily household” consists of a person living alone or a householder who shares the home with nonrelatives only; for example, with roommates or an unmarried partner.

Family households (63.7%) predominate on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe, although traditional married couple families are in the minority (16.5%), a rate lower than the State (47.4%) or County (48.4%). Households headed by a female head of household (single moms) account for two-fifths (41.8%) of all households. Three-fifths (58.3%) of all households are either married couple families (16.5%) or households headed by single mothers (41.8%). See Table 8 and Figure 7.

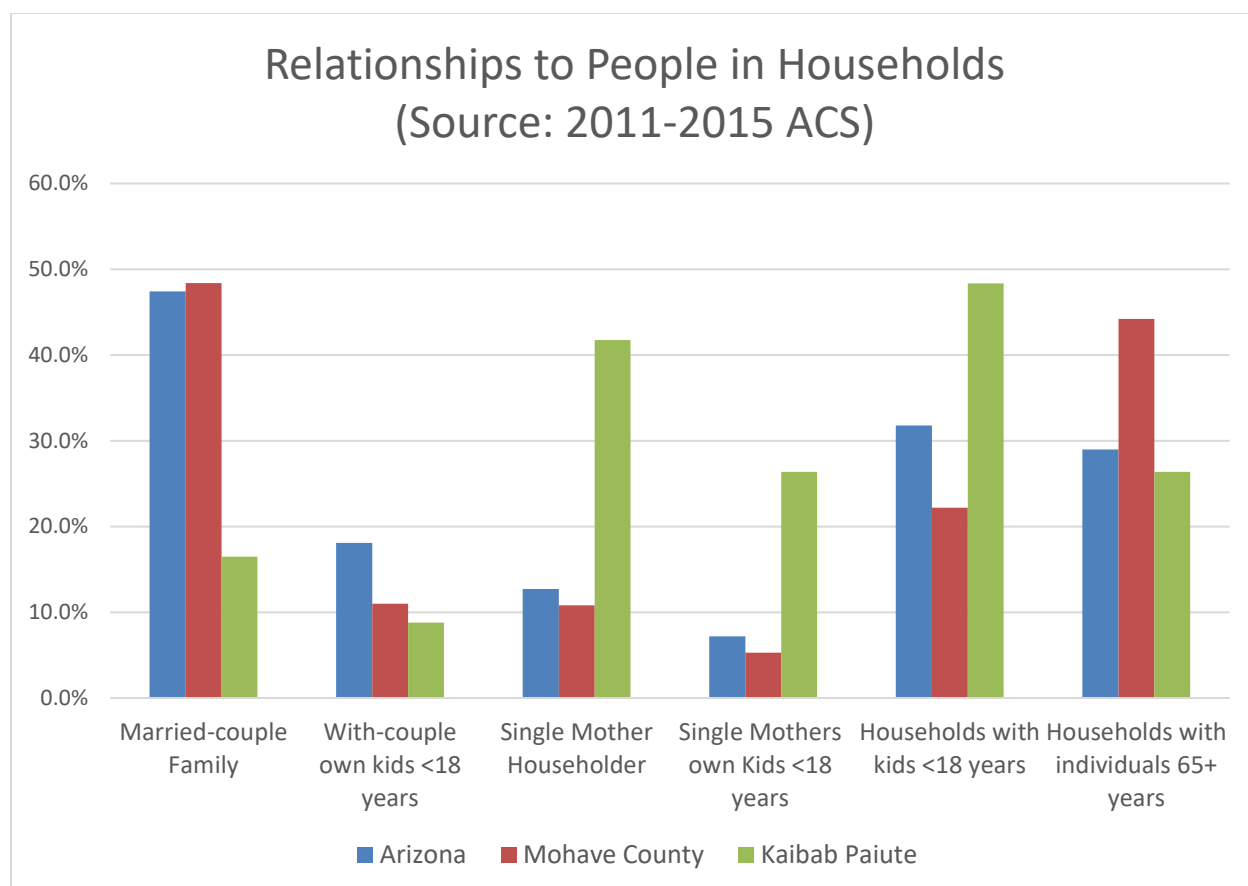

Households with children under age 18 (48.4%) occur in almost half of the households, a much higher rate for Kaibab Paiute Tribe than for the State (28.1%) or the County (18.6%). Householder with a member over age 65 account for more than one third (26.4%) of all households, lower than the state (29.0%), and the County (44.2%). Finally, tribal households are more likely to be headed by a single mother with their own children under age 18 (48.4%) a rate higher than that of the State (31.8%) or the County (22.2%).

Figure 7. Household relationships



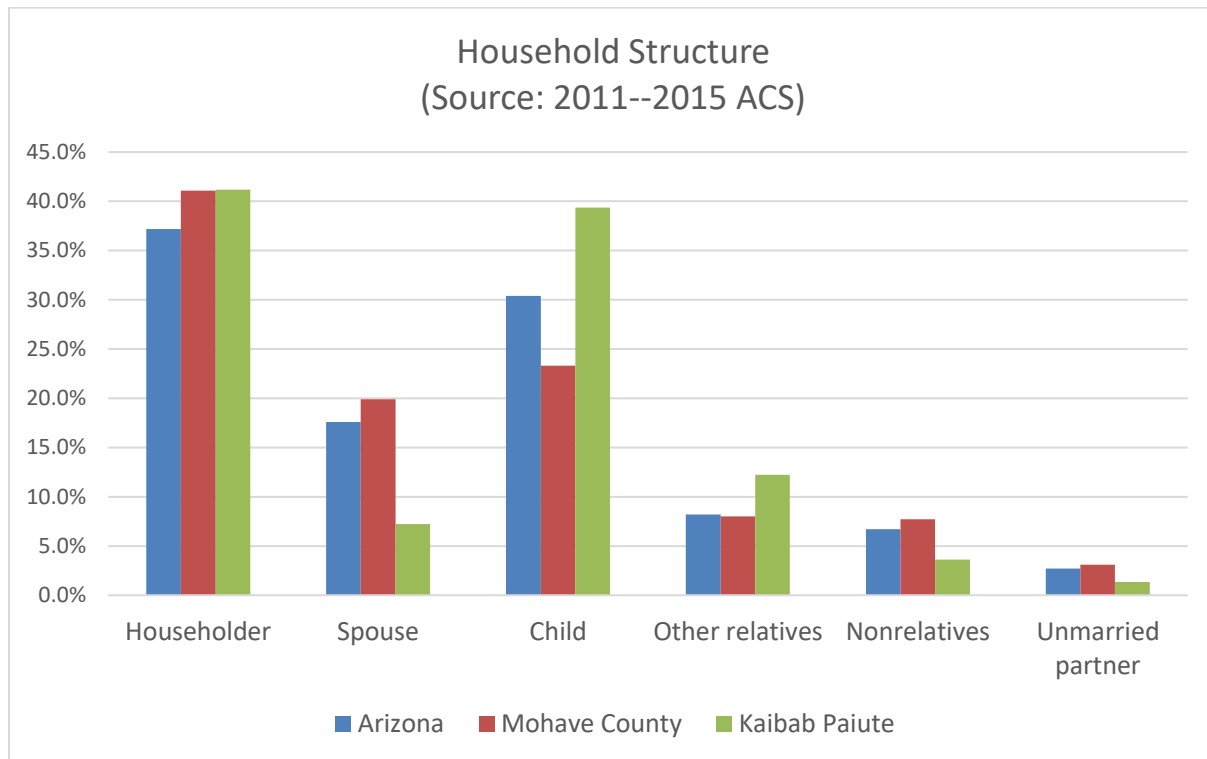
In terms of household characteristics only 41.2 percent of all Kaibab Paiute households are headed by a householder, a higher rate than the State (37.2%) but similar to the County (41.1%). Spouse-headed households comprise a smaller share of Kaibab Paiute tribal households (7.2%) than the State (17.6%) or the County (19.9%). Households containing children comprise more than one-third of all households (39.4%), greater than the State (30.4%) or the County (23.3%). See Table 9 and Figure 8.

Family households dominate among Kaibab Paiute tribal members (63.7%), slightly less than the State (66%) and County (64%). Non-family households account for one-third (36.3%) of tribal member households, less than the State (45%) or County (48%). Husband and wife families account for less than one-fifth (16.5%) of households, whereas residents of the State (47%) and the County (48%) are more likely to live in husband and wife households. Households on Kaibab Paiute Tribe are three times more likely to be headed by a female householder (41.8%) with no husband present. Households headed by single mothers are far less prevalent at the State (13.0%) or County (11.0%) levels. Households on Kaibab Paiute Tribe are more likely (34.5%) to have children under the age of 18 living in the household, a rate greater than the State (24%) or the County (19%). Figure 9. Households headed by single mothers

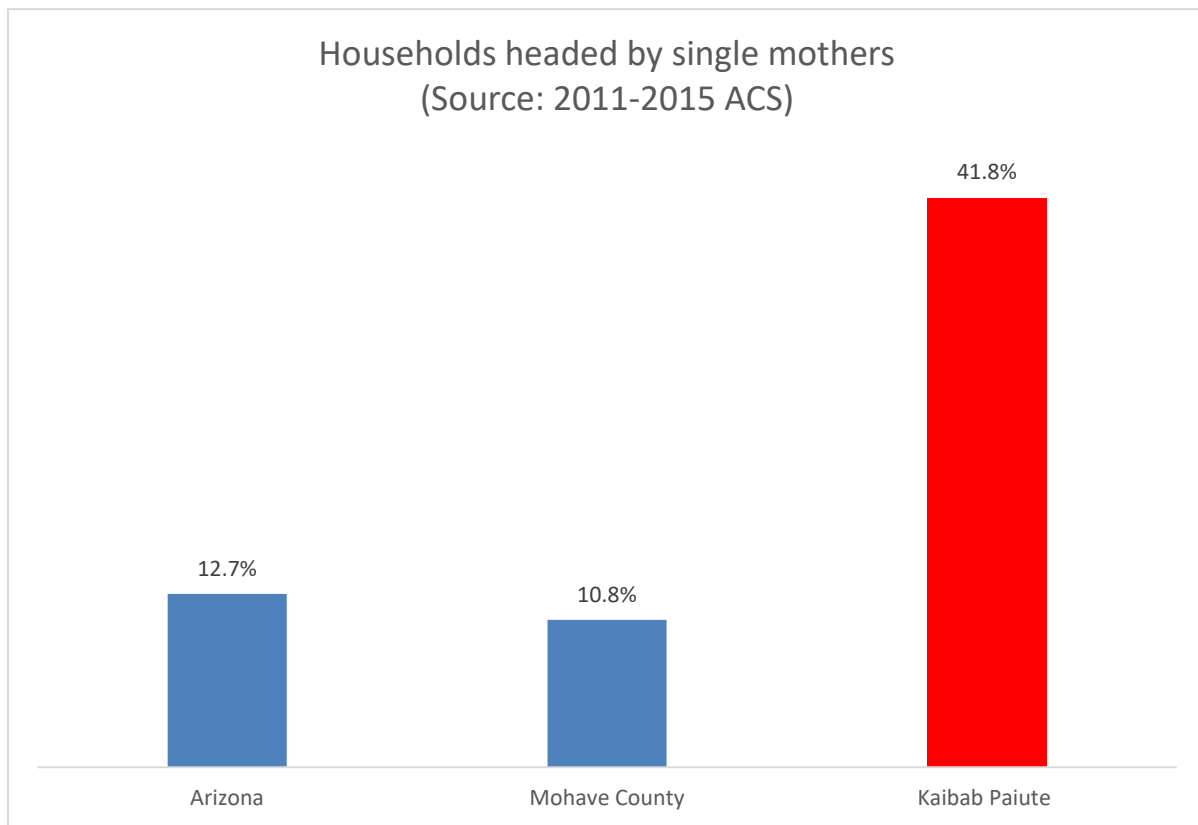

Children Under 18 Years Age Living with Grandparent

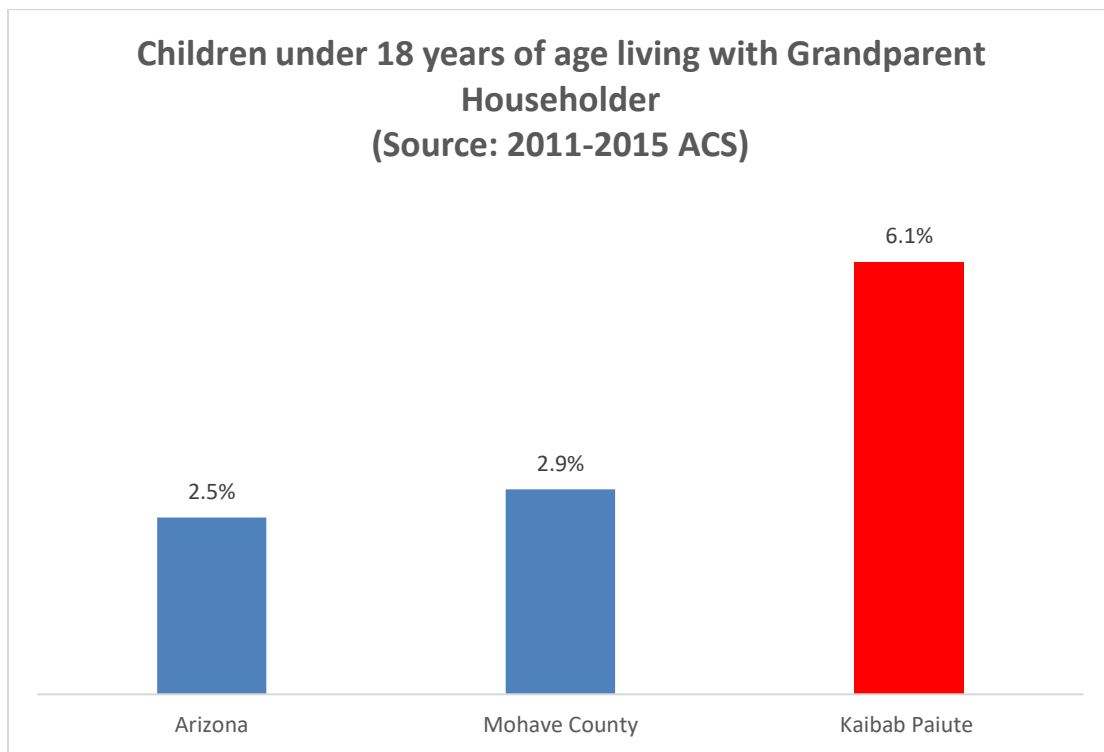
Children under age 18 are twice as likely to live with grandparents on Kaibab Paiute Tribe (6.1%) than they are at the State level (2.5%) or in the County (2.9%). There are few differences between the proportions of children by age living with grandparents; the exception is that more children 1 to 2 years live with their grandparents (75%) in Kaibab Paiute Tribe than at the State or County levels. Household Income

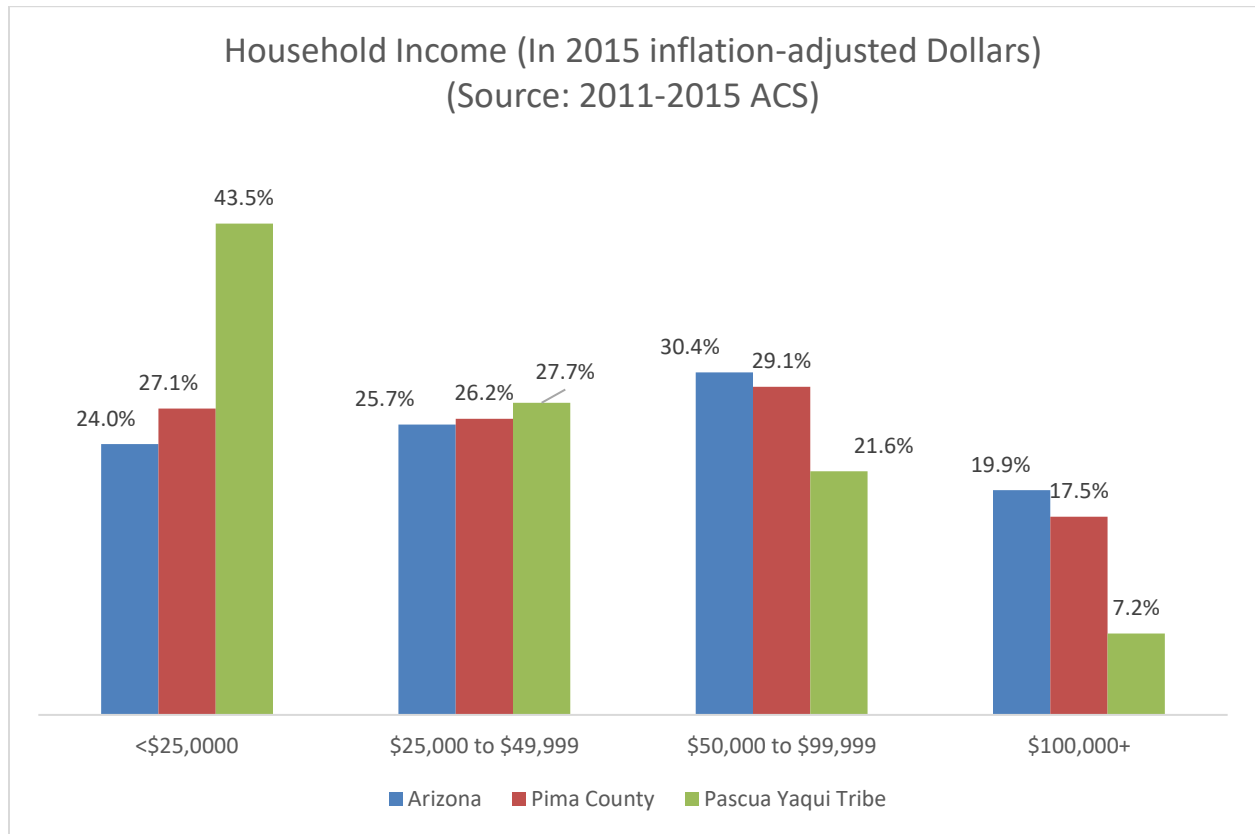
The median household income for Kaibab Paiute Tribe is \$21,250, less than the County (\$38,488) or the State (\$50,255). Tribal members are more likely to have lower household incomes than either the State or the County. In fact, households are almost twice as likely to have incomes of less than \$25,000 (53.8%) than the State (24%) or the County (31%). Tribal members (24%) have the same level of household incomes between \$25,000 and \$49,999 as the State (26%) while the County (32%). Correspondingly, fewer tribal households have incomes in excess of \$100,000 (1.1%) than the County (10.0%) while the State (20%) has the highest level of incomes in excess of \$100,000. Households on Kaibab Paiute Tribe are twice as likely (27%) to receive Food Stamps than are residents of the State (14%) and the County (17%). See Table 13 and Figure 12.

Figure 12. Supplemental income

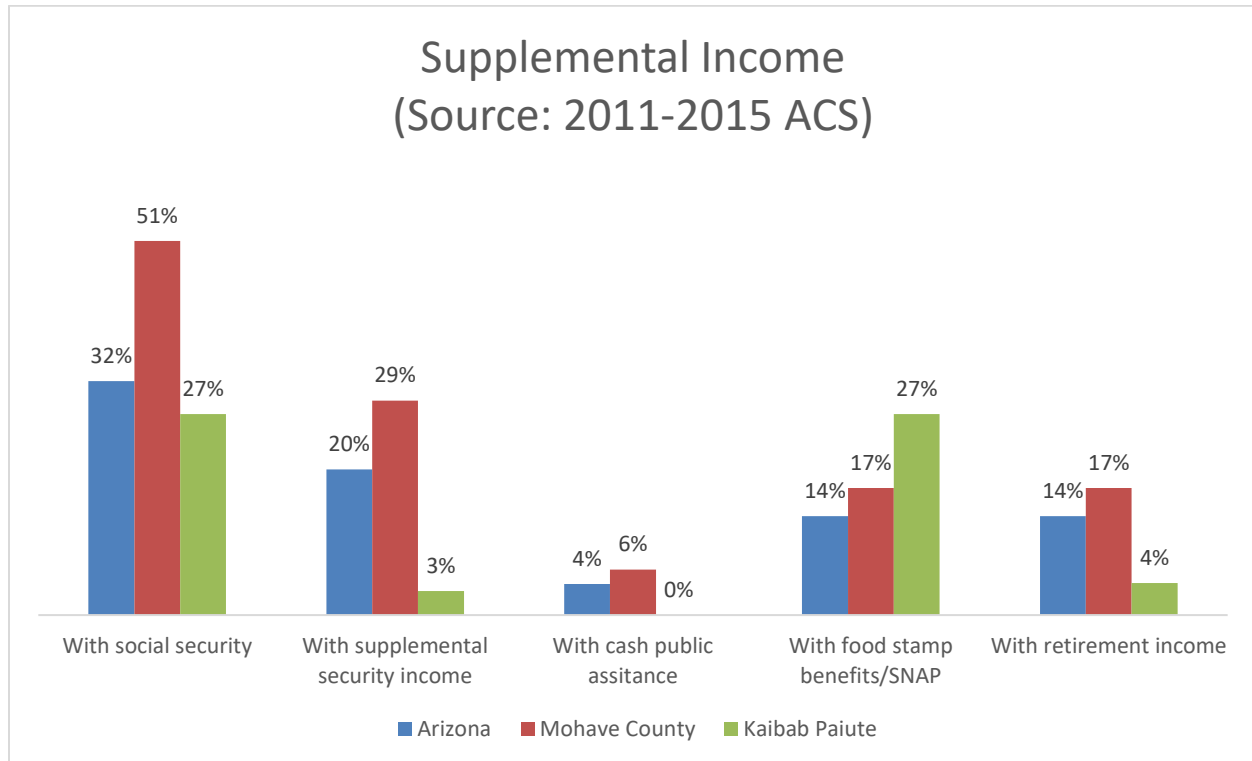

Other Income

Per capita Income on Kaibab Paiute Tribe (\$11,671) is about half that of per capita income for the County (\$20,974) and the State (\$25,848). Correspondingly, median earnings for workers cannot be calculated due to small sample sizes. See Table 14

Poverty

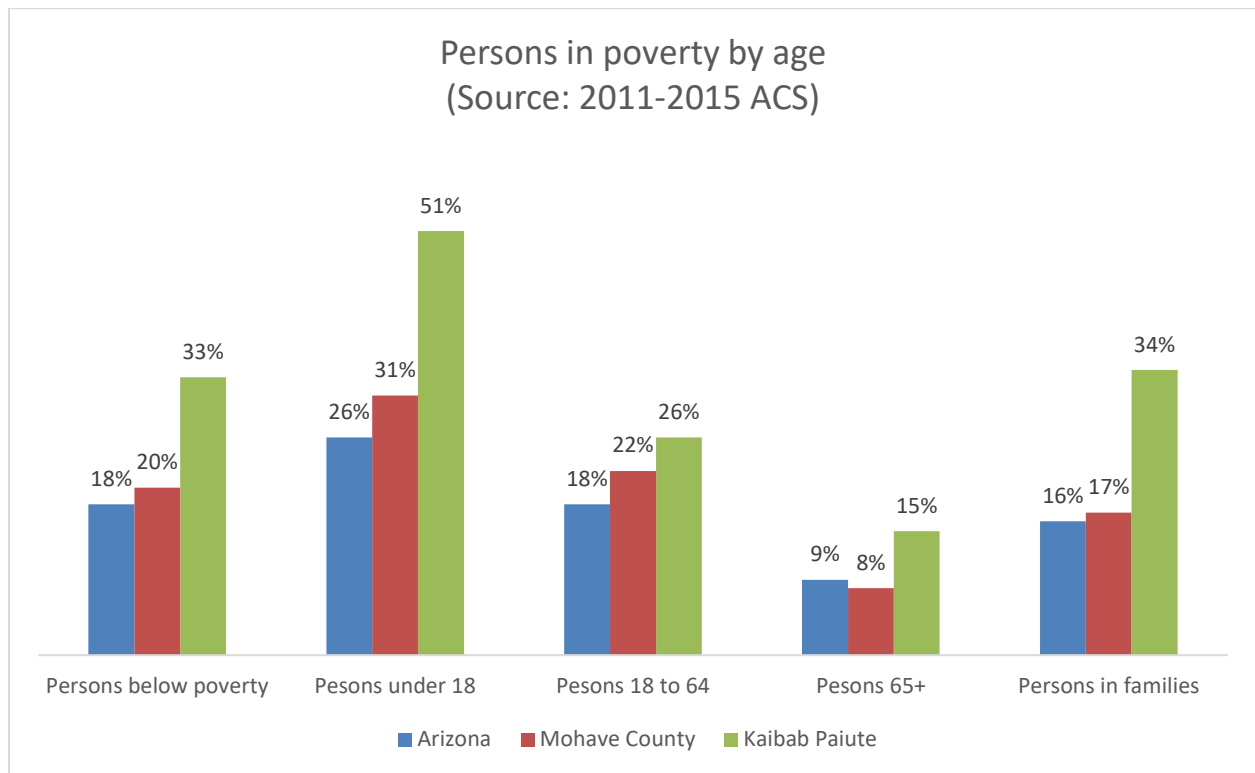
Poverty rates on Kaibab Paiute Tribe (33%) are almost twice as high as the State (18%) and the County (20%). Half (51%) of all children under 18 years of age are considered to be living in poverty, while one-fourth (26%) of tribal members between 18 and 64 also live in poverty. One-tenth (15%) of tribal members over 65 years of age live in poverty, almost twice the State (9%) and the County (8%). See Table 15 and Figure 13.

Children in Poverty

The rates of children under 18 years of age living in poverty on the Kaibab Paiute Reservation is 47.4 percent are higher the same as the State (30.9%) and higher than the County (27.3%).

The highest poverty rates for tribal members are recorded for children between the ages 12 and 17 years, of whom 30 percent of these school age children live below the poverty line. See Table 16. ACS Table B17001 was used to create this table.

Persons in Poverty

The Census Bureau uses a set of money income thresholds that vary by family size and composition to determine who is poor. If a family's income is less than a family's threshold, then that family and every individual in it, is considered poor. Further the ratio of income to poverty can be used to measure the degree or depth of poverty. The ratio of income to poverty compares a person's income with their poverty threshold, and expresses the comparison as a fraction. For example, a poverty ratio of 1.0 (income at 100% of poverty level) means a person is living right at the poverty line; a ratio of 0.5 (income at 50% of poverty level) would mean that a person is living in a household making only half the income designated as the poverty threshold. The Census Bureau describes those with family incomes below one half of their poverty threshold as being "severely poor." People with incomes at or above their threshold but below 125 percent of their threshold are classified as "near poor."

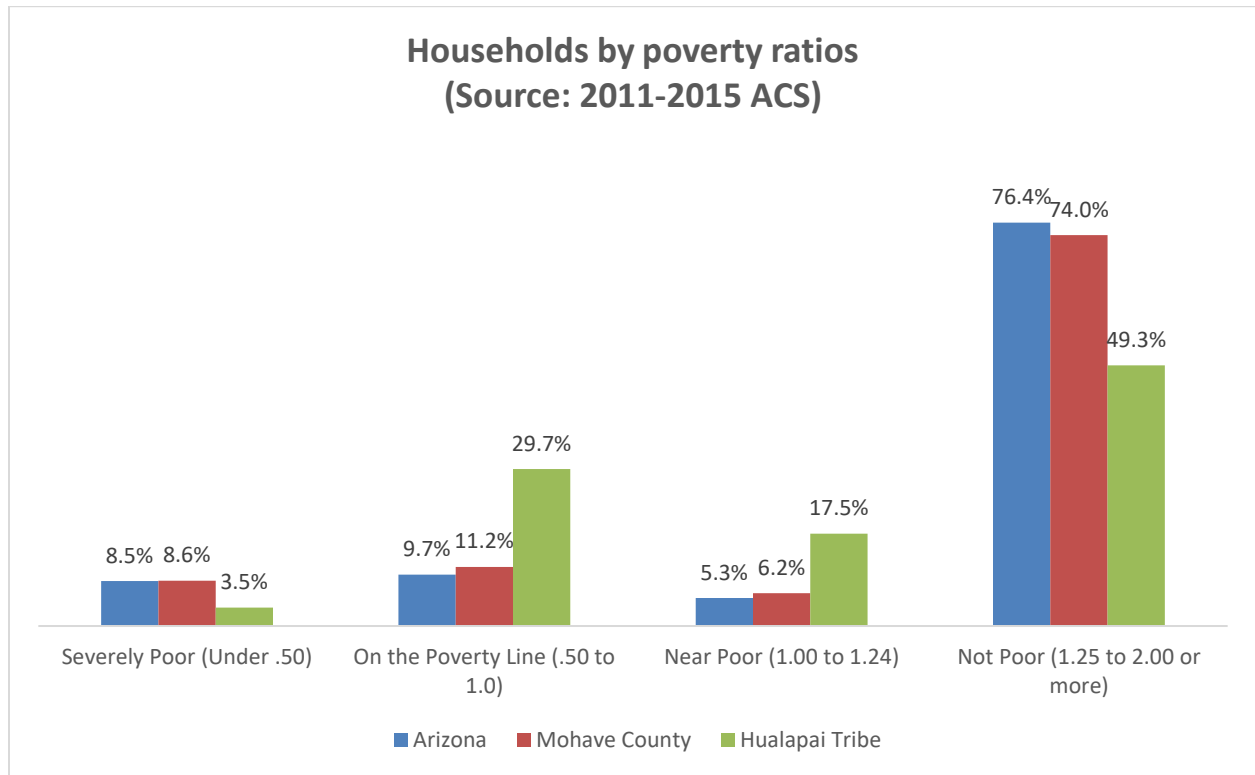
One-third (33%) of those living on Kaibab Paiute Tribe are classified as "severely poor," with poverty ratios that ranges from below 0.5 to .99. These rates are almost twice those of the State (18%) and higher than the County (20%). A further 17.5 percent of tribal members are classified as "near poor" with poverty ratios between 1.00 and 1.24. These data indicate that 51 percent of Kaibab Paiute households are living in poverty, while the remaining 49percent are classified as not living in poverty. See Table 17 and Figure 14. Households Receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

One-fourth (27.4%) of all households on the Kaibab Paiute Reservation receive assistance from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). This rate is at least two times higher than the State (13.5%) and higher than the County (17.3%). One-fifth of households receiving SNAP assistance (20%) have at least one person in the household over 60 years of age. This rate is higher than the County (6.2%), and more than eight times the State rate (3.5%). See Table 18. ACS Table S2201 was used to create this table.

Fertility

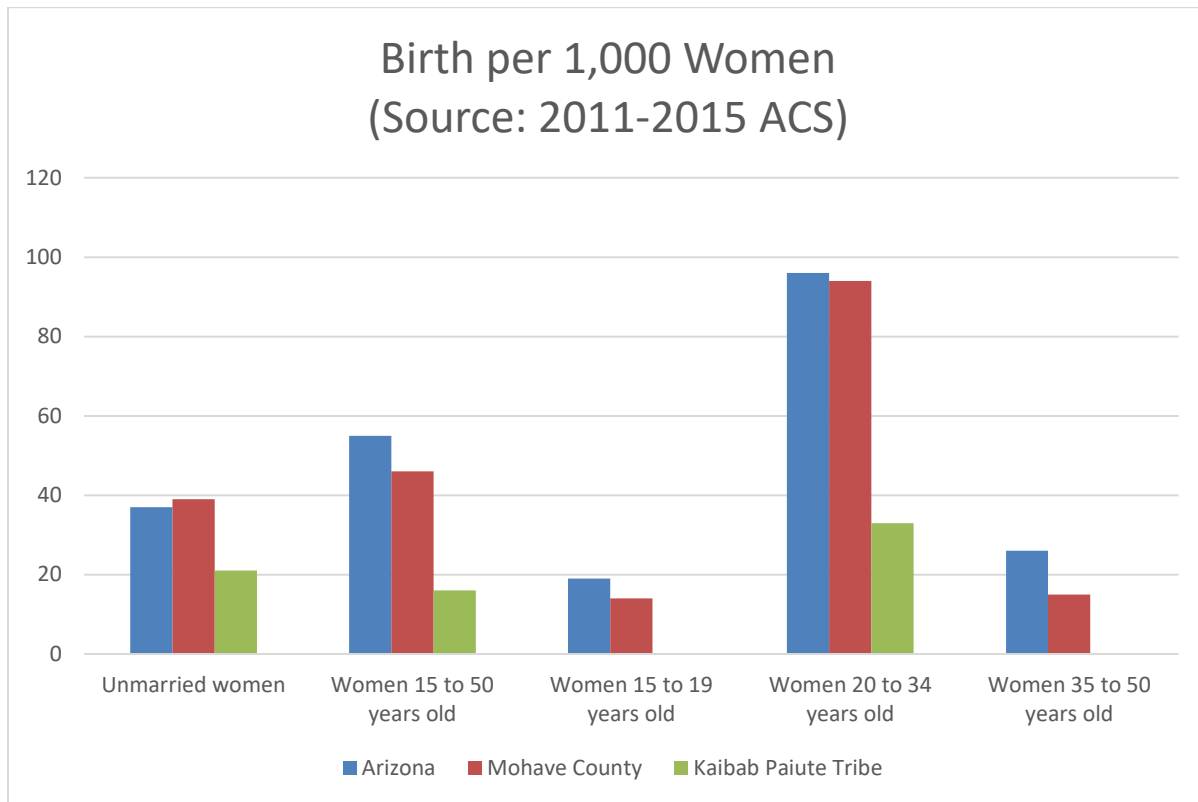

ACS Margin of Error Estimates

The ACS estimates are based on data from a sample of housing units and people in the population, not the full populations. For this reason, ACS estimates have a degree of uncertainty associated with them, called sampling error. In general, the larger the sample, the smaller the level of sampling error. The ACS calculates standard errors for each estimate produced and publishes the 90 percent confidence level margins of error (the Census Bureau standard). You can be 90 percent confident that the interval within the margin of error from the estimate includes the true value. Users can add and subtract the margin of error value from the estimate to find the top and bottom of the range within which the ACS is 90 percent confident that their estimate lies in.

Understanding margin of error

A term you will often come across in survey research is "within the margin of error." Most people hear the term frequently during election season when results from polls are reported. Many surveys and polls collect data from a representative sample of a population to make determinations about a larger population. Results would be somewhat different each time the survey is administered to a different representative sample. The margin of error accounts for these differences by calculating an upper and lower boundary the true result would likely fall between if every member of population was surveyed.

For example, in the case of Kaibab Paiute Tribe the ACS has established that there are 229 persons present on the Kaibab Paiute Reservation. The survey also indicates that there are 91 males and 138 females in the total population, with a margin of error of plus or minus (\pm) 37 males and (\pm) 71 females. See Table 2 margin of error estimates. The margin of error tells us that if the same survey were administered to the Kaibab Paiute Tribal members again, it is highly probable that the true population for males would be between 54 and 128 males and similarly that the true population of females would be between 67 and 209.
