Total outdoor recreation

Outdoor recreation value added (also referred to as GDP) consists of the value of outdoor recreation goods and services produced less the value of expenses incurred for their production. The activity of self-employed individuals is included in value added.

Outdoor recreation employment consists of all full-time, part-

time, and temporary wage-and-salary jobs in which the workers

are engaged in the production of outdoor recreation goods and

services. Self-employed individuals are excluded from

employment totals.

Outdoor recreation compensation consists of the pay to employees (including wages and salaries and benefits such as employer contributions to pension and health funds) in return for their outdoor recreation-related work during a given year. Pay to the selfemployed is excluded from compensation but included in value added.
