

## **Radiation Safety Briefing Documentation**

1. Identification of areas where radioactive material is used or stored.
2. Types and amounts of radiation and/or radioactive materials to which Facility/Staff and/or Students could be exposed while working at Northern Arizona University (NAU)..
3. Health effects of exposure to ionizing radiation.
4. Response in the event of spills, emergencies and unsafe conditions.
5. Locations where the licensee has been posted or made available, notices, copies of pertinent rules, and copies of pertinent licenses and license conditions (including applications and applicable correspondence), as required by AAC R12-1-1002.
6. Personnel monitoring program.
7. Rights of workers to have access to radiation exposure and bioassay records.
8. Responsibilities of personnel using radioactive material, including the need to bring violations of ARRA and NAU rules and regulations to the attention of the RSO.
