

# Call for Applications Spring 2026 Drickamer-Sellers Award for Community-Based Experiences

(open to all currently enrolled NAU Honors students)

The NAU Honors College is pleased to accept applications for the Spring 2026 Drickamer-Sellers Award for Community-Based Experiences. Funded through a generous gift, the awards support immersive student learning through community engagement and experiential education. The award is \$2,000 per semester, and students are expected to be enrolled in three credit hours of Honors independent study or field work. Students are welcome to work individually or in pairs. Those working in pairs should plan to submit separate applications that reference the collaborative project; if the application is successful, each team member will be awarded \$2,000 for the semester.

**Applications are due November 15, 2025, by 5:00 PM PDT.** The application form is attached to this document. Interested students should note the following:

- 1. Awardees will be expected to enroll in credit-bearing Honors independent research or field work hours while holding the award.
- 2. Awardees are eligible to apply for additional support.
- 3. The attached application requires a proposal that includes a description of research; signature from a faculty mentor; and plans for presenting the results of the research, including a brief impact video.
