To be completed at Pima Community College:

☐ **Associate of Arts.** An Associate of Arts incorporates an **AGEC-A:** The Arizona General Education Curriculum (AGEC) is the foundation of a community college education in Arizona. Successfully completing the AGECE means all AGECE courses will transfer as a block to NAU. An AGECE is incorporated into some Associate degrees, and some degree requirements will also fill AGECE requirements.

Additional Considerations:

- This is offered at the Flagstaff Campus, Yuma, and Online.
- This program is accredited by the [Council on Social Work Education](#) (CSWE).
- NAU's BSW requires a secondary application. Admission requirements include a "B" or better in SW 220 – Introduction to Social Work or equivalent course, as well as a minimum gpa of 2.25 and 24 credits or more completed or in progress. Courses below identified with an asterisk can be completed prior to admission to the BSW program.
- NAU offers two MSW/Master of Social Work graduate degree programs: 2-year MSW (for those who have NOT completed a BSW program) and 1-year MSW - Advanced Standing (for those who have completed a BSW program). Completion of NAU's BSW with a GPA of 3.3 or better prepares students for the accelerated-based, 1-year, MSW - Advanced Standing program. Admission to NAU's MSW must be within 5 years of completion of the BSW.
