Possible Sanctions or Supportive Measures That University May Impose Following the Results of Any University Investigative Proceeding under this Policy

The following sets forth a non-exhaustive list of potential remedies for complainants, which the University may impose. Some possible sanctions include additional training or education, suspension, termination, and expulsion. The University may provide immediate steps and interim measures to ensure the safety and well-being of the Complainant, such as counseling, extensions of deadlines or other course-related adjustments, modifications of work or class schedules, campus escort services, mutual restrictions on contact between parties, changes in work or housing locations, leaves of absence, increased security and monitoring of certain areas of the campus, and other similar measures.
