




Our Mission

Background:

With a commitment to working inclusively, collaboratively and effectively with all stakeholders to improve education in Arizona, our organizational goals are to:

- Develop support for improved outcomes on Education Progress Meter indicators
- Reach the state's 60% attainment goal by 2030, working through the P-20 continuum
- Close achievement gaps at all levels
- Advocate for state-level funding allocated to those most in need





Key Strategies

- Building public and political will for significant education improvement (**Voice**)
- Championing and supporting efforts that advance the Arizona Education Progress Meter goals and prioritize closing achievement gaps (Policy)
- Developing and scaling innovative programs that support low-income and students of color (**Programs**)



Arizona Education Progress Meter



QUALITY EARLY LEARNING

Percent of Arizona 3- and 4-year old children that are in quality early learning settings.



THIRD GRADE READING

Percent of Arizona 3rd grade students who scored Proficient or Highly Proficient on the AzM2 3rd grade English language arts assessment.



EIGHTH GRADE MATH

Percent of Arizona 8th grade students who are prepared to be successful in high school math.



HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

Percent of Arizona high school students graduating in 4 years.



OPPORTUNITY YOUTH

Percent of 16-24 year olds in Arizona that are NOT going to school or working.



POST-HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT

Percent of high school graduates enrolled in postsecondary education the year after graduating high school.



ATTAINMENT

Percent of Arizona residents 25-64 years of age who have completed a 2or 4-year degree or who have an active professional certificate or license.



Achieve60AZ Goal Drives our Work



ATTAINMENT

Percent of Arizona residents 25-64 years of age who have completed a 2-or 4-year degree or who have an active professional certificate or license.

- 60% of Adults (25-64) will hold a credential or degree by 2030. We need 500K more certificates & degrees
- Our role:
 - Driving policy and funding
 - Collecting/sharing data
 - Acheive60AZ Alliance
 - Providing scholarships and mentoring to students
 - Supporting local action teams





Overview:

Education Forward Arizona plays a critical role in the Achieve60 – AZ GEAR UP Plan by providing services in the following three areas:

- Postsecondary Enrollment: provide services that help high school students enroll into college
- First Year Postsecondary Support: provide mentoring to ensure persistence
- Community Engagement & Collaborations: professional development and college readiness

Community Engagement:

• The Community Impact Team (CI) is based regionally around the state and connects with local communities to share the importance of education, deliver presentations, convene meetings and network with partners



Goals:

- Raise awareness of the importance of quality education and build public will for significant education improvements
- Develop and share effective messaging for the importance of P-20 education statewide
- Craft a shared agenda to reach the Arizona Education Progress Meter Goals
- Ensure timely and accurate data are available in the Education Progress Meter



Examples of actions taken:

Launch of the Achieve60 Action Plan in spring 2023 to identify steps communities can take to advance the Education Progress Meter goals in their local community

Sharing of information around "Everything to Gain" economic impact of the value

of education through presentations and networking statewide

Convening local attainment groups around the state:
 Mohave, La Paz, West Valley, Page, Douglas, Yuma

- Updating the Education Progress Meter annually and making accurate data available on the website
- Reinvigorating AZCAN and launching additional CAP courses




