
Our Partner Schools (2012 – 2019)

- 3,400 students
- Rural
 - 59% Hispanic
 - 27% White
 - 8% Native American
 - 6% all others
- Cohort F/R Lunch rate = 70%
- ESL & IRP rates ~ 10%

Current Grant Cycle (2019 - 2026)

- Priority Model (previous grants operated on a Cohort Model)
 - 5E's of Equity Engage, Empower, Excel, Elevate, and Enrich

- 41 High Schools (A60 Schools)
 - Prioritize senior-year services
 - 5 of 41 schools direct services from AZGU 9-12th grade
 - 36 of 41 schools senior-year services + resources from partner organizations
