LMS implementation updates, June 2023

Dear colleagues,

With the summer term underway and fall planning beginning, we wanted to share continued updates on our work with Instructure's Canvas as our next Learning Management System (LMS).

Initial launch in summer and looking ahead to fall

Students and faculty in our summer sessions thus far have already begun using Canvas. Given the extraordinary complexity an LMS change over demands, the transition has gone smoothly, and we are continuing to improve our work in supporting faculty as we gather your feedback. We are well positioned for the fall semester—and a reminder that all instruction in fall will continue to will take place with Canvas.

Continued migration

In addition to the self-migration work faculty are engaging in, we are continuing to roll out batches of K16-assisted migrations: The next round is scheduled for June 26, and subsequent dates for future batches are July 28, August 11, and August 23. Please review our previous communications for more information on our recommended actions to take before submitting a request for K16-assisted migration, which will help ensure the process goes smoothly—see <u>Bb Learn to Canvas Pre-Migration Guide</u> for more information and the <u>K16 Canvas Migration Form</u> to request a K16 migration.
