PURPOSE AND CRITERIA

Awarded to an undergraduate student at NAU who has demonstrated the following:

1. A high level of academic achievement,
2. Leadership, and
3. Service, both to the University community and community at large.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Be enrolled full time as a resident or on-line Undergraduate Student at NAU,
2. Have completed at least 24 credit hours of coursework at NAU,
3. Have earned a minimum grade point average of 3.0, and
4. Have at least one semester remaining in their undergraduate academic studies at NAU.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

1. A completed Faculty Senate Scholarship Application Form on following page,
2. A copy of an NAU transcript (unofficial transcripts are acceptable),
3. One letter of recommendation from a member of the NAU faculty. The letter may accompany the application form or be sent separately (see below) and received by the application deadline, and
4. A personal statement describing the applicant's activities at NAU as they relate to the scholarship criteria. The personal statement shall be type-written in 12-point font, contain no more than 800 words, and be attached to the Scholarship Application Form.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

All application materials must be received in the Faculty Senate Office by 5:00 PM on Friday, March 22, 2024.
